- The International Aviation Summit in Delhi was organised by the Ministry of Civil Aviation (MoCA) in collaboration with the International Air Transport Association (IATA) to discuss the importance of the Indian aviation market, and what it will take for the aviation sector to expand in India while maximizing the economic and social benefits of the potential growth.

- The Union Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) approved to increase the wages of artisans by over **36 percent**, With this, the wages will be increased from **Rs 5.50** per hank previously to **Rs 7.50** per hank.

- ❖ A **Five Judge** Constitution Bench of the **Supreme Court** on September 6, 2018 decriminalised **Section 377** of the Indian Penal Code **(IPC)** by partially striking down some of its provisions. lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender **(LGBT)** has equal citizenship and **equal protection of laws.**
 - ✓ The **Yogyakarta Principles** animates **Article 14**. Homosexuals have a **fundamental right** to live with dignity, are entitled to be treated as human beings and imbibe the spirit of fraternity.
- Ministry of Tourism sanctioned Malanad Malabar Cruise Tourism Project under Swadesh Darshan Scheme for development of rural circuit in Kerala.
 - ✓ The project will be focusing on development of **water-based** thematic cruise experiences in and around **Valapattanam** and **Kuppam Rivers** of **Kannur** District to tap potential of water tourism of Kerala.
 - ✓ Swadesh Darshan Scheme
 - The scheme was launched by **Union Tourism Ministry** with an objective to develop theme-based tourist circuits in the country. Under this scheme, **13 thematic circuits** have been identified for development.
 - It is 100% centrally funded scheme for the project components undertaken for public funding.
 - ✓ **Capital**: Thiruvananthapuram, **Chief minister**: Pinarayi Vijayan, **Governor**: Palanisamy Sathasivam
- The National Nutrition Month (Rashtriya Poshan Maah) is being celebrated across the country in **September 2018** to mark fight against malnutrition.
 - ✓ The National Nutrition Month will also focus on **adolescent girls**, **pregnant women** and **lactating mothers** to eliminate the deficiencies prevailing in the **Health sector**.

- Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved establishment and operationalization of permanent campus of seven new Indian Institutes of Management (IIMs).
 - ✓ These IIMs will be established at Amritsar (Punjab), Bodh Gaya (Bihar), Nagpur (Maharashtra), Sambalpur (Odisha), Sirmaur (Himachal Pradesh), Vishakhapatnam (Andhra Pradesh) and Jammu.
- Union Ministry of Railways has launched Rail Sahyog web portal (www.railsahyog.in). It will provide platform for Corporates and PSUs to fund creation of amenities at railway stations through Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) funds
- The World Summit on Accreditation (WOSA-2018) was held New Delhi. It was inaugurated by Union Minister for Human Resource Development (HRD) Prakash Javadekar.
 - ✓ **Theme: -** "Challenges and Opportunities in Outcome Based Accreditation".
 - ✓ **WOSA 2018**:- The Summit facilitated exchange of information on various challenges being faced during transition between input-output based accreditation to outcome based accreditation.
- The World Hindu Congress-2018 was held Chicago, United States. It was organized to commemorate 125th years of Swami Vivekananda's historic Chicago address on September 11, 1893.
 - ✓ The theme of WHC-2018 was "Sumantrite Suvikrante"- think collectively, achieve valiantly". It was 2nd edition of World Hindu Congress and was attended by Vice President Venkaiah Naidu.
- ❖ The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved continuation of Capacity Development Scheme for period 2017-18 to 2019-20 with an outley of Rs 2,250 crore. It is ongoing Central Sector Scheme of Ministry of Statistics and Program Implementation (MoSPI).
 - ✓ It has 2 sub schemes: Economic Census and Support for Statistical Strengthening (SSS).
 - ✓ **Union Minister of MOSPI**:-Shri D. V. Sadananda Gowda, **Minister of State**:-Shri Vijay Goel.
- ❖ The Union Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare has launched Dairy Processing & Infrastructure Development Fund (DIDF) Scheme with an outlay of Rs. 10881 crore. Under this fund, first installment of Rs. 440 crore was given to National Dairy Development Board (NDDB).
- The Union Ministry for Minority Affairs minister Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi has launched the country's first National Scholarship Portal Mobile App (NSP Mobile App). It aims to provide smooth, accessible and hassle-free scholarship system for students from poor and weaker sections.
- The Union Human Resource Development (HRD) Minister Prakash Javadekar in the first week of September 2018 decided to end the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) boycott.
 - ✓ Resultantly, the ministry will send a team of officers to Paris this year to negotiate India's terms of participation in PISA
 2021 with the Organisation for Economic Cooperation Development (OECD).
 - ✓ PISA Test
 - The Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA) was introduced in the year 2000 by the Organisation for Economic Cooperation Development (OECD).
 - **PISA** is a competency-based test. It tests the learning levels of **15-year**-old students in reading, **mathematics** and **science**. The test is carried out once in every three years.
 - As on date, there are **80 countries** participating in PISA, including China and Vietnam.
 - ✓ OECD Founded: 30 September 196, Headquarter: Paris, France, Secretary-General: José Ángel Gurría
- Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved proposal for introduction of Bill in Parliament for amendment of National Institutes of Design (NID) Act, 2014 for establishing four new NIDs across the country.

- The **Election Commission** announced the withdrawal of the provision of **None Of The Above** (NOTA) option from ballet papers for elections to **Rajya Sabha** and **legislative council** in **states**.
- Minister of State for Housing and Urban Affairs, Hardeep Singh Puri inaugurated first regional workshop on Real Estate Regulatory Authority (RERA) in Pune, Maharashtra.
 - ✓ Chief Minister: Devendra Fadnavis,

- ❖ The Union Home Minister Shri Rajnath Singh inaugurated the 6th International Geriatric Orthopaedic Society of India Conference at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences , New Delhi.
 - ✓ **Theme**:-Increased Longevity with Reduced Fragility and Enhanced Mobility.
- ❖ The Union cabinet approved a proposal for the 100% electrification of Indian Railways by 2021-22, reducing dependence on imported fossil fuel and saving revenue for the national carrier.
- The Department of Empowerment of Persons with Disabilities (Divyangjan), Ministry of Social Justice & Empowerment organized a 1-day 'National Conference of District Disability Rehabilitation Centres' at Dr. Ambedkar International Centre, New Delhi.
- ❖ Union Minister of State for Tourism K J Alphons inaugurated the country's first tribal tourism circuit in Dhamtari district of Chhattisgarh.

- Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has launched e-Sahaj portal to facilitate individuals and private companies in seeking security clearance for setting up businesses in certain sensitive sectors.
 - ✓ **e-Sahaj portal:** The portal will help to strike **healthy balance** between meeting imperatives of national security and facilitating ease of doing business and promoting investment in the country,
- ❖ Union Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MoEFCC) on eve of World Ozone Day (17th September) released draft India Cooling Action Plan (ICAP). It makes India first country in world to develop such document.
- ❖ NITI Aayog in its recently report has recommended that Ministry of Agriculture to take up mission on shifting cultivation to ensure inter-ministerial convergence between different ministries. The report was titled "Mission on Shifting Cultivation: Towards a Transformational Approach".
 - ✓ NITI Aayog Formed: 1 January 2015, Headquarter: New Delhi, CEO: Amitabh Ka
- Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs (CCEA) has approved Revised Cost Estimate of Dam Rehabilitation and Improvement Project (DRIP). It has been increased to Rs. 3,466 crore from earlier Rs. 1968 crore. CCEA also gave approval for 2-year time extension for project from July 2018 to June 2020.
 - ✓ **DRIP**: The project **aims** to improve safety and operational performance of **198 Dams** from seven states (69 from Tamil Nadu), along with institutional strengthening with system wide management approach.
- The Employee's State Insurance (ESI) has rolled out Atal Bimit Vyakti Kalyan Yojna for providing unemployment allowance to workers rendered jobless due to changing employment pattern.
- Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has launched pilot project for Transport of Sputum Specimen for Tuberculosis (TB) Diagnosis by utilising services of Department of Post in Karawal Nagar, New Delhi.
- The **foundation** stone of world-class convention centre **India International Convention and Expo Centre** (IICC) was laid by Prime Minister **Narendra Modi** in **New Delhi** at an estimated cost of **Rs 25, 703 crores**.
 - ✓ The project is planned over an area of **221.37 acre** in Sector 25, **Dwarka**, New Delhi.
 - ✓ The IICC will be an integrated complex with a host of mutually beneficial facilities such as exhibition halls, convention centre comprising plenary hall, ballroom and meeting rooms, a multi-purpose arena, open exhibition spaces, mixed-use commercial spaces like star hotels, retail services and high-end offices.
- The Cabinet Committee on Economic Affairs, chaired by the Prime Minister Narendra Modi approved ASHA Benefit Package with effect from October, 2018, which will be paid in November 2018.
 - ✓ ASHA facilitators will be **enrolled** in the Union Government's **social security schemes** including the Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJY) and Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).
 - ✓ Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana:
 - The eligibility criteria for ASHAs and ASHA Facilitators to be covered under Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (Life Insurance) include those who are aged between **18-70 years**.
 - The insurance cover would be for a one-year period stretching from June 1 to May 31 and the benefits include:
 - Rs 2 Lakh in case of death due to an accident.
 - Rs 2 Lakh in case of total and irrecoverable loss of both eyes or loss of use of both hands or feet or loss of sight of one eye and loss of use of one hand or one foot.
 - Rs 1 Lakh in case of total and irrecoverable loss of sight of one eye or loss of use of one hand or one foot.
 - The annual premium of Rs 12 per beneficiary will be paid by the Union Government.
 - ✓ Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana:
 - The eligibility criteria for ASHAs and ASHA Facilitators to be covered under Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (Accident Insurance) include those who are aged between **18-50 years**.
 - The insurance cover would be for a one-year period stretching from June 1 to May 31.
 - The benefit includes Rs 2 Lakh in case of death due to any cause (accident and natural).
 - The annual premium of Rs 330 (average) will be paid by the Central Government.
- President Ram Nath Kovind launched the logo and the web portal for commemoration of 150th birth anniversary of Father of the Nation, Mahatma Gandhi. that is observed in the form of two year long celebrations from October 2, 2018 to October 2, 2020 across the country and all over the globe.
 - ✓ The logo branding will be done in trains, metro rail, air India aircrafts, state roadways buses, government websites, emails, government stationery, calendar, government advertisements and digital signature.
 - ✓ The web portal 'http://gandhi.gov.in' is participatory in nature and all the participating organisations will be able to upload their activities regarding commemoration on the website.
- Union Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has launched Cyber Crime Prevention against Women and Children (CCPWC) portal (www.cybercrime.gov.in) to check objectionable online content. The portal will allow citizens to lodge complaints on objectionable online content related to child pornography, child sexual abuse material and sexually explicit material such as rape and gang rape.

- The Union Minister for Railways and Coal, Mr. Piyush Goyal inaugurated the 'first ever' India Tourism Mart (ITM 2018) in the presence of the Tourism Minister of Morocco, Mr. Mohamed Sajid.  - ✓ **DBHPS** is national organisation that aims to improve **Hindi literacy** among non-**Hindi speaking** people of South India.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated New airport in Jharsuguda-also known as the powerhouse of Odisha. PM also flagged off the UDAN flight on Jharsuguda-Raipur sector. It is first airport in Odisha to provide necessary connectivity to Bhubaneswar, Raipur and Ranchi under Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS)- Ude Desh Ka Aam Naagrik (UDAN) Scheme.
 - ✓ The name of this airport has been named freedom fighter **Veer Surendra Sai.**
- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi launched ambitious Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY), under Ayushman Bharat umbrella at Ranchi, Jharkhand. The scheme aims to provide annual health insurance cover of Rs 5 lakh to 10.74 crore beneficiary families i.e. over 50 crore beneficiaries across India. The scheme will become operational from September 25, 2018 i.e. on birth anniversary of Deendayal Upadhyay.
 - ✓ Recently The **Union Government** has announced that the treatment of **childhood cancer** will be covered under **Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana**.
- ❖ Indian Govt Develops 'Cyber Trivia' App for Kids, Against Dangerous Blue Whale & Momo Challenge.
 - ✓ According to the National Commission for Protection of Child Rights, **Cyber trivia' app** being developed by the **Indian government** will throw **multiple choice questions** to children, rewarding them with points for correct answers.
- The 21st Central Zonal Council meeting was held in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh. It was chaired by Union Home Minister Rajnath Singh.
 - ✓ The Council discussed various issues including road transport, Pradhanmantri Gramin Sadak Yojna, measures to tackle Naxal violence, modernization of Police, infrastructure development of airports, minimum support price, National health mission and issues related to primary schools.
- ❖ Union Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs had held 2-day National Orientation workshop on National e-Vidhan Application (NeVA) in New Delhi.
 - ✓ **NeVA** is initiative of Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs. It aims to make all legislatures in the **country paperless** by making proceedings of houses **digital**.
- ❖ Vice-President M Venkaiah Naidu inaugurated Indian Culinary Institute (ICI) in Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh. It is promoted by Union Ministry of Tourism. The ICI building was designed by National Building Construction Corporation (NBCC).
 - ✓ The main objective of ICI is to institutionalize mechanism to support efforts intended to preserve, document, promote and disseminate Indian Cuisine.
- Dr Harsh Vardhan, the union Minister of Environment, Forest and Climate change (MoEF&CC), has inaugurated air pollution control device-Wind Augmentation Purifying Unit (WAYU) at ITO in New Delhi.
 - ✓ WAYU is developed by Council of Scientific and Industrial Research–National Environmental Engineering Research Institute (CSIR-NEERI) to mitigate air pollution at traffic junctions.
- ♦ Minister of State for Labour and Employment, Santosh Kumar Gangwar inaugurated the 7th National Conference on Excellence in Workplace Safety and Occupational Health in New Delhi.
- ❖ Union Cabinet chaired by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved National Digital Communications Policy-2018 (NDCP 2018). It replaces existing National Telecom Policy-2012 to cater to the modern needs of the digital communications sector of India.
- Union Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare launched online software for processing applications Agmark quality certification mark for agricultural products.
 - ✓ **Agmark online system**: It is being implemented across the country to conduct quality control functions. It will be available 24×7. It will make process of application is simple, quick, transparent.
- Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs Minister Hardeep Singh Puri inaugurates International conference on plastics recycling and waste management in New Delhi.
- ❖ Union Government has enhanced its contribution in State Disaster Response fund (SDRF) from 75% to 90%. With this enhancement Central Government's additional contribution in SDRF will be Rs. 1690.35 crore for the year 2018-19 and Rs. 1774.67 crore for the financial year 2019-20.

- According to recent study published in **Lancet Global Health** journal, at least **34%** of **India's** population is **insufficiently** active. The levels of insufficient activity were higher among **women** at **48%**, while prevalence was **22 %** among men.
- ❖ International Women Entrepreneurs Summit 2018 was held in Kathmandu, capital of Nepal, The theme of 3-day summit was "Equality begins with Economic Empowerment". It was organised by the South Asian Women Development Forum (SAWDF).

- The 4th BIMSTEC Summit concluded in Kathmandu with signing and adoption of Kathmandu Declaration by all the 7 members (India, Nepal, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Sri Lanka, Myanmar and Thailand).
 - ✓ **The 18-point** Kathmandu Declaration aims to enhance effectiveness of BIMSTEC Secretariat by engaging it in various technical and economic activities in the region.
