

NATIONAL AFFAIRS

- An ambitious web-based single-window system **Pro-Active and Responsive facilitation by Interactive, Virtuous and Environmental Single-window Hub** (Parivesh) for **environmental clearances** will be rolled-out at state levels by **January 15**. Parivesh provides for an automated system for **submission**, **clearance** and **monitoring**.
 - ✓ Parivesh is a web-based workflow application which has been developed for online submission and monitoring of the proposals submitted by the proponents for seeking Environment, Forest, Wildlife and CRZ Clearances from Central, State and district level authorities.
- India is likely to achieve 100 per cent household electrification before 2019 Republic Day. India has already provided electricity access to 2.39 crore out of the targeted 2.49 crore households under the Pradhan Mantri Sahaj Bijli Har Ghar Yojana (Saubhagya scheme).
 - ✓ India has attained the **100% electrification** of the families in **25 states** by **December 2018**. Around 10.48 lakh families are remained to be electrified in **Four states** of **Assam**, **Rajasthan**, **Meghalaya**, Chhattisgarh.
- ❖ The **Central Government** has launched the following mechanisms for the monitoring of **quality of education** in Government schools: **ShaGun Portal**.
 - ✓ About SE Shagun: In Hindi, 'Shala' means 'School' and 'Gunvatta' means 'Quality'. Additionally, 'Shagun' means 'good omen'. which has two parts.
 - One of which is a Repository of good practices, photographs, videos, studies, newspaper articles etc on school education, State /UT wise has been developed which is in public domain.
 - The **second part**: Through Shagun, the data collection and reporting processes have been simplified; resulting in a totally transparent and efficient system.
- The Government gave out the 6-crore free cooking gas (LPG) connection as the scheme to make available cleaner fuel in every household kitchens under the Pradhan Mantri Ujjwala Yojana (PMUY).
 - ✓ PMUY was launched in May 2016 with tagline of Swachh Indhan, Behtar Jeevan and a target to give 5 crore connections by March 2019. The target was later raised to 8 crore connections by 2021.
- The Food Safety and Standards Authority of India (FSSAI) notified the new food packaging regulations, replacing all provisions regarding the packaging requirements prescribed in the Food Safety and Standards (Packaging and Labelling) Regulations, 2011 to comply with new regulations by July 1, 2019.
 - ✓ Notified new packaging regulations which prohibit use of newspaper or recycled plastics for packing, wrapping, storing, transporting or dispensing articles of food products.
 - ✓ FSSAI: Headquarter: New Delhi,
- The Indian Parliament passed the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education (Amendment) Bill, 2018 that seeks to do away with the no-detention policy in schools.
- The Union Cabinet approved the restructuring of existing National Health Agency as "National Health Authority" for better implementation of the Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (PMJAY).
 - ✓ Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (Ayushman Bharat or AB-NHPM): launched on September 23, 2018 and started operation from September 25, 2018, the birth anniversary of Deendayal Upadhyay.
 - Provides free coverage of up to Rs 5 lakh per family per year.
 - The insurance cost is shared by the centre and the state mostly in the ratio of 60:40.
- ❖ Indian Railways form the backbone of the Indian Transportation System. The Railways has undertaken following measures under its Go Green initiatives: Ministry of Railways has planned to set up 1000 Mega Watt (MW) solar power by 2020-21.
- ❖ The Government has launched the "Green-Ag project: Transforming Indian Agriculture for global environmental benefits and the conservation of critical biodiversity and forest landscapes" in association with Global Environment Facility (GEF).
 - ✓ The project would be implemented in collaboration with the **Food and Agriculture Organisation** (FAO) in high-conservation-value landscapes of **five States** namely, (i) **Madhya Pradesh**: Chambal Landscape, (ii) **Mizoram**: Dampa Landscape, (iii) **Odisha**: Similipal Landscape, (iv) **Rajasthan**: Desert National Park Landscape and v) **Uttarakhand**: Corbett-Rajaji Landscape.

- ❖ The Centre has released around Rs 185 crore since financial year 2015-2016 to bridge the gap between literacy levels of tribal girls and the general female population. Another Rs 65.44 crore was released in financial year 2016-17, Rs 46.28 crore in the 2017-18 fiscal and has so far released Rs 20.36 crore in 2018-19.
- The Lok Sabha has passed the 124th constitutional amendment bill to provide 10 per cent reservation in jobs and higher education for those belonging to the economically backward sections of the general category. The government aims to provide the aid of reservation to economically backward poor people who are not availing the benefit of reservation as of now.
 - ✓ Those owning more than 5 acre land will be excluded.
 - ✓ Those having a **residential plot** of more than **1000 square feet** will not be eligible for this reservation.
 - ✓ People owning a plot more than **100 square yard** in a **notified municipality** will also not be able to benefit from the government's latest move.
 - ✓ Those owning a **plot more than 200 yards** in non-notified areas will also be excluded from 10% reservation for the general class and those earning annual income of more than **Rs 8 lakh per annum**.
- Rail Kumbh Seva Mobile App has been launched by the North Central Railway (NCR) to help the devotees arriving in Allahabad for the Kumbh Mela.
- As per the announcement made to set up a **high-level committee** to review the implementation of **clause 6** of the **Assam** Accord, the government has set up a committee headed by former Union tourism secretary **M.P. Bezbaruah**.
- ❖ The Ministry of Human Resource Development has launched 70-Point Grading Index to assess the quality of school education in the states.
- The Ministry of Textiles, Government of India had launched a Yarn Bank Scheme as one of the components of Power Tex India scheme with an aim to avoid fluctuation in yarn price.
 - ✓ To provide **interest-free** corpus fund to **Special Purpose Vehicle** (SPV) or Consortium to enable them to purchase yarn at a wholesale rate and give the yarn at a reasonable price to the small weavers.
- The Union Finance Minister Arun Jaitley has released a Facebook post titled 'Benefits of the Aadhaar-where it stands today' highlighting how the efficient use of the Aadhaar based identification has aided in improving the governance and in efficient delivery of services.
 - ✓ He said that implementing Aadhaar has enabled the government to save Rs 90,000 crore until March 2018.
- Singapore based, Asia competitiveness institute (ACI) has released the Ease of Doing Business Rankings for Indian states.
 - ✓ Andhra Pradesh has topped followed by Maharashtra and Delhi.
- **❖** The **Lok Sabha** has passed the **New Delhi International Arbitration Centre Bill** to set up a revamped **International Arbitration Centre** at **New Delhi** with an aim to make India the hub of arbitration.
 - ✓ **Arbitration** is a settlement of dispute between two parties to a contract by a neutral third party i.e. the arbitrator without resorting to court action.
- The 27th edition of New Delhi World Book Fair was held at the Pragati Maidan, New Delhi. Theme: Book For Readers with special needs". The UAE's 3rd largest emirate Sharjah is the guest of honour for the New Delhi World Book Fair.
 - ✓ **UAE**: **Capital**: Abu Dhabi,

- Currency: Dirham.
- **♦ The Cabinet** approves continuation of **Rastriya Yuva Sashaktikaran Karyakram Scheme** for the Period **2017-18 to 2019-2020** with budget outlay of **Rs.1160 crore**.
 - ✓ The Scheme aims to develop the personality and leadership qualities of the youth and to engage them in nation building activities.
- ❖ Prime Minister Narendra Modi inaugurated the 106th 'Indian Science Congress-2019' from 3rd to 7th January 2019 in Lovely Professional University Jalandhar, Punjab. Government's aim is to deliver the benefits of Science & Technology to the last man in the society.
 - ✓ To be inaugurated on the 2nd day of ISC, 4th January 2019, **Children's Science Congress**.
 - ✓ Third day of ISC, two-day Science Communicators Meet- 2019. On 5th January, 'Women's Science Congress.
 - ✓ Theme of ISC-2019: 'Future India: Science and Technology'.
- ✓ Punjab: Chief Minister: Amarinder Singh,

- Governor: V.P Singh Badnore.
- Arunima Sinha became the world's first female amputee to climb Mount Vinson, the highest peak of Antarctica.
- ❖ The **Ministry of Human Resource Development** constituted a task force to look into the circumstances of reported suicides of **49 students**, of residential **Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas** (JNVs) between 2013 and 2017.
 - ✓ The task force, to be headed by psychiatrist **Dr. Jitendra Nagpal**.
 - ✓ Apart from this, the **Union Minister** of Human Resource Development **Prakash Javadekar** has announced an increase of around **5,000 seats** at **Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas** across the country.
- The Union Ministry of Human Resource Development (HRD) has recently approved the establishment of a Centre for Classical Language at the Thunchath Ezhuthachan Malayalam University in Tirur, Kerala. The Ministry has communicated the decision to the Central Institute of Indian Languages, Mysuru.

- ❖ The 25th edition of the Partnership Summit 2019 would be inaugurated by Vice President of India, M Venkaiah Naidu in Mumbai.
 - ✓ The Partnership Summit 2019 will showcase India in the present landscape of an emerging "New India" and the "New Global Economic Address" like Artificial Intelligence, big data, agri and food processing, defence and aeronautics, renewable energy and tourism.
- Industrial body Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industries (FICCI) and global consulting firm PwC released India Manufacturing Barometer 2019 Report. The report contains details about various variables of Indian Economy.
 - ✓ According to report, **12 per cent** to the **manufacturing Gross Domestic Product** (GDP) of the country from the automobiles, chemicals, electrical machinery, food processing, leather, pharmaceuticals and textiles sectors.
 - ✓ **India's economy** is projected to grow anywhere between **7.3–7.7 per cent**. India aspiring to become a **\$5 trillion** economy in the next few years.
- The Union Environment Minister **Harsh Vardhan** launched the **National Clean Air Programme** (NCAP). The programme aims to tackle the challenge of **increasing pollution** in the cities and towns.
 - ✓ A five-year action plan with a tentative target of 20-30% reduction in concentrations of PM10 and PM2.5 by 2024, with 2017 as the base year. The plan includes 102 non-attainment cities, across 23 states and Union territories.
- The Minister for Electronics and IT (MeitY) Ravi Shankar Prasad inaugurated the National Informatics Centre (NIC)'s Command and Control Centre (CCC) and its Centre for Excellence in Artificial Intelligence.
 - ✓ The **Command and Control Centre** is set up as a **specialized facility** with a nationwide view of **ICT infrastructure** for effective monitoring and management of the performance & availability of all these critical services.
- The Supreme Court has suggested setting up of a 3-member panel comprising of Nandan Nilekani, a co-founder of Infosys, and renowned computer scientist Vijay P Bhatkar to suggest reforms for conducting of competitive examinations fairly by government bodies.
- ❖ The Union Cabinet headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved the setting up of 3 new AIIMS institutions. The 3 new institutions would come up at Vijaynagar at Samba of Jammu, Awantipora in Pulwama of Kashmir and Rajkot in Gujarat under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana.
 - ✓ **PMSSY** was announced in **2003** with objectives of correcting regional imbalances in the availability of affordable/ reliable tertiary healthcare services and also to augment facilities for quality medical education in the country.
 - ✓ It has two components:
 - Setting up new AIIMS (All India Institute of Medical Sciences)
 - Upgradation of government medical colleges in various states.
- The Ministry of Women and Child Development, Government of India has launched an online campaign Web-Wonder Women to discover and celebrate the exceptional achievements of women, who have been driving positive agenda of social change via social media.
- The Prime Minister Narendra Modi dedicated to the nation, Gangajal project, which will provide Agra with better and more assured water supply, at an estimated cost of Rs.2880 crores. Gangajal project aims to bring 140 cusecs of Ganga water to Agra.
- The **Ministry of Personnel**, Public Grievances and Pensions has initiated an inter-ministerial consultation note to rename the **Indian Forest Service** as **Indian Forest and Tribal Service**.
 - ✓ The renaming of the IFS to IFTS was suggested by the **National Commission for Scheduled Tribes** (NCST) to ensure cordial **relations** between the **IFS officials** and **tribals** as both were in close contact with eachother.
- The Ministry of Industries and Commerce had initiated the National Programme for Organic Production (NPOP) to assist the organic producers to tap the market which is growing steadily in the both in domestic and export segments.
- The Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers Welfare is implementing the scheme of Rashtriya Gokul Mission to conserve and develop indigenous breeds in a focused and scientific manner.
 - ✓ The scheme comprises of two components namely National Programme for Bovine Breeding (NPBB) and National Mission on Bovine Productivity (NMBP).
 - ✓ Budget 2019: fund allocated Rs 750 crore for them under the Rashtriya Gokul Mission (RGM).
- The All India Radio celebrates National Poets Conference (Sarva Bhasha Kavi Sammelan), was held in Chennai.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired Union Cabinet approved creation of the post of Vice Chancellor for National Rail & Transport Institute set up in Vadodara, Gujarat.
- The 4th meeting of the Council for Trade Development and Promotion (CTDP), chaired by Union Minister for Commerce & Industry and Civil Aviation, Suresh Prabhu, was held in New Delhi.
 - CTDP was constituted in July 2015, to ensure a continuous dialogue with State Governments/UTs on measures for providing International Trade enabling environments.

The good quality Research Journals in disciplines under Social Sciences, Humanities, Languages, Arts, Culture, Indian Knowledge Systems etc., will be maintained by CARE.
 - ✓ **UGC: Headquarter**: New Delhi, **Chairman**: D.P. Singh.
- The 15th Pravasi Bharatiya Divas (PBD) was held in Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh) from January 21 to January 23, 2019. Its theme was "Role of Indian Diaspora in building a New India".
 - ✓ It was organized by the **Ministry of External Affairs** (MEA) in association with the **government of Uttar Pradesh**.
 - ✓ PBD is celebrated on 9 January. But this time dates were shifted to allow the guests attending the event to get an opportunity to participate in the 'Kumbh Mela' at Prayagraj and to attend the Republic Day parade.
- The Union Minister of Housing and Urban affairs Hardeep Singh Puri launched the Global Housing Technology Challenge. The challenge is undertaken under the Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana Urban (PMAY-U).
- The Union Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has given its approval for its Rs 13,384.80 crore Sita Rama Lift Irrigation Project of Telangana. that aims to divert Godavari river water to irrigate 2.72 lakh hectare in three districts of Telangana Bhadradri Kothagudem, Khammam and Mahabubabad.
- Finance Minister Shri Arun Jaitley and Union Minority Affairs Minister Shri Mukhtar Abbas Naqvi inaugurated Hunar Haat exhibitions in New Delhi. Hunar Haat plays an important role in national and international branding of the heritage of master artisans in India. - The 29th biennial Indian Paint Conference has started in Agra, Uttar Pradesh. It is organized by the Indian Paint Association (IPA). The theme of the Conference is 'Paints Pe Charcha-Naye Aayaam'.

- The Central Government has asked the states to step-up the spending under District Mineral Fund as just 24 per cent of the Rs 23,606-crore mopped up under the Pradhan Mantri Khanij Kshetra Kalyan Yojana (PMKKKY) was actually spent. The Central Government has also issued directions to ensure that there is no fund diversion or leakage.
- ❖ The Biofuels are being considered an alternative to reduce the country's crude oil imports worth Rs7 lakh crore. They can also be a potential weapon to fight increasing pollution. The findings of the research by the Pune-based Automotive Research Association of India (ARAI) have substantiated the potential reduction in the emissions of the carbon-di-oxide by the adoption of methanol blending.

- South African President Cyril Ramaphosa delivered the first IBSA (India, Brazil, South Africa) Gandhi-Mandela Memorial Freedom Lecture in New Delhi.
 - ✓ **IBSA** is an international tripartite grouping for **promoting international cooperation** among India, Brazil and South Africa.
- The Union Cabinet headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved the signing of Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between India and Kuwait for cooperation on the recruitment of domestic workers.
- ❖ The Pakistan government declared sugarcane juice as the "National drink" of the country.

- El-Nino disturbs the atmospheric conditions across the world. El-Nino occurs every 2-to-7 years with very strong El Niño's occurring about every 15 years results in droughts, floods, wildfires, dust and snow storms, fish kill, and even elevated risks of civil conflicts.

 - Angel tax is a term used to refer to the income tax payable on capital raised by startup companies via the issue of shares where the share price is seen in excess of the fair market value of the shares sold. The excess realization is treated as income and taxed accordingly.

- The Reserve Bank of India has proposed a one-time loan restructuring scheme for micro, small and medium enterprises (MSMEs).
