

NATIONAL AFFAIRS

- The commerce ministry has laid out a detailed procedure for claiming benefits under the Transport and Marketing Assistance (TMA) scheme, which aims at boosting agricultural exports.
 - ✓ The government announced this scheme for providing financial assistance for transport and marketing of agriculture products to boost exports of such commodities to certain countries in Europe and North America.
- The Ministry of Home Affairs has constituted Unlawful Activities (Prevention) Tribunal, to determine the sufficient cause to ban Jamaat-e-Islami, and Jammu and Kashmir Liberation Front (JKLF) faction. It headed by Justice Chander Shekhar of the Delhi High Court.
- International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) Red List of Threatened Species hump-back mahseer a large freshwater fish also known as 'Tor remadevii' or 'tiger of water' and found only in the Cauvery river basin (including Kerala's Pambar, Kabini and Bhavani rivers)- is now "Critically Endangered" species list. IUCN: Headquarter: Gland, Switzerland, CEO: Inger Andersen.
- The Environment Pollution (Prevention and Control) Authority (EPCA) comes out with parking management plan for Delhi. In report, agency flags free parking on public land, multiplicity of agencies to be key cause of congestion and parking menace.
- Vice President of India, Shri M. Venkaiah Naidu, inaugurated GRIDTECH-2019, 6th International Exhibition and Conference on 3rd April 2019. This international event has been organized by **PowerGrid Corporation of India Limited** (POWERGRID), with the support of Ministry of Power, Government of India and in association with Central Board Of Irrigation And Power (CBIP) and Indian Electrical and Electronics Manufacturers' Association (IEEMA) at Pragati Maidan, New Delhi.
 - ✓ This international event will showcase new technologies in the fields of Transmission, Distribution, Renewable Integration, Smart Grid, Communication etc.
- The Centre has extended the "disturbed area" tag under Armed Forces Special Powers Act (AFSPA) for three districts of Arunachal Pradesh for another six months, while withdrawing it partly from three other districts bordering Assam.
- The Maitri Bridge, the longest suspension bridge over the Indus River at Choglamsar village in Leh was opened to the public. ✓ The bridge has been named 'Maitri Bridge', symbolising the excellent civil-military relations existing in the Leh-Ladakh
- region. A National Seminar on "Greenery and Landscaping" was organized by the Central Public Works Department (CPWD). The * seminar focused on Green Urban Areas.
- The International Centre for Automotive Technology (ICAT) will organize a NuGen Mobility Summit, 2019, at * Manesar, NCR, from 27th to 29th November 2019.
 - ✓ The objective of the Summit is to share new ideas, learnings, global experiences, innovations and future technology trends for faster adoption, assimilation and development of advanced automotive technologies for a smarter and greener future.
- ** The National Institution for Transforming India (NITI Aayog) together with Rocky Mountain Institute (RMI) has released a report titled "India's Electric Mobility Transformation: Progress to Date and Future Opportunities". The report analyses the opportunities for the automobile sector and government under the Faster Adoption and Manufacturing of Electric Vehicles II (FAME II) scheme.
 - ✓ NITI: Formed: 1 January 2015, Headquarter: New Delhi, CEO: Amitabh Kan.
- The National Cardiology Conference 2019 has been started at Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute of medical sciences in Lucknow, Uttar Pradesh.
 - ✓ The conference being held for the first time in Uttar Pradesh to provide an opportunity to showcase newer innovations in Cardiology which can help to deliver cost-effective cardiology care for the patients. Governor: Ram Naik.
 - ✓ Uttar Pradesh: Chief Minister: Yogi Adityanath,
- The National Handloom week is being observed from 7th April to 14th April this year. On this occasion, a book named 'The Indian textile Sourcebook' authored by Avalon Fotheringham and published by Thames and Hudson will launch on 9th April.
- * Ministry of Health and Family Welfare along with World Health Organization (WHO) formed a Solidarity Human Chain as part of the World Health Day celebrations to reaffirm their commitment to bridging gaps and working collaboratively towards Universal Health Coverage.



- The quality of air in Varanasi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi's 2014 Lok Sabha constituency, is positioned 3rd on the WHO's (World Health Organisation) list of 15 most polluted cities in the world, by the 'Political Leaders Position and Action on Air Quality in India 2014-2019' report, released by Climate Trends. Kanpur (Uttar Pradesh) is the most polluted city in the world and is positioned 1 on the list.
 - Faridabad in Haryana is in 2nd position after Kanpur, whereas Delhi is ranked 6th on the list. Other than these, the list of the most polluted cities according to WHO include Gaya and Patna in Bihar, Lucknow, Cities of Agra, Muzaffarpur, Srinagar, Gurugram, Jaipur, Patiala and Jodhpur.
- A bench headed by NGT (National Green Tribunal) Chairperson Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel has formed a Central Monitoring Committee to enforce a national plan to reduce the river pollution.
- The Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) and the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) have joined hands to map, validate and protect smaller wetlands in coastal regions. The programme is aimed at restoring them through coastal livelihood programmes.
 - A memorandum of understanding (MoU) was signed between the CMFRI and the Space Applications Centre of ISRO to develop a mobile app and a centralised web portal that will have a comprehensive database of wetlands that are smaller than 2.25 hectares in the country.

- The 100th anniversary Jallianwallah Bagh Massacre also known as the Amritsar massacre was observed.
 - On 13th April 1919 a huge number of people gathered at Jallianwala Bagh in Amritsar to celebrate the harvest festival of Baisakhi and to protest against the Rowlatt Act.
- The 8th edition of Home Expo India 2019 opened at India Expo Centre and Mart, Greater Noida. The three-day exhibition has been organized by the Export Promotion Council for Handicrafts (EPCH).
 - ✓ Home Expo India covers sectors with maximum thrust and growth potential in home decor, furnishing, furniture, flooring, and textiles.
 - ✓ EPCH is the nodal export promotion body for handicrafts in India and plays an important role with the main objective of boosting trade in handicrafts and also projects India's image in the global market as a reliable supplier.
- President Ram Nath Kovind and Vice President M Venkaiah Naidu have greeted the people on occasion of 'Mahavir Jayanti'.
 - This day marks the birth of Vardhamana Mahavira, who was the 24th and the last Tirthankara who succeeded the 23rd
 Tirthankara, Parshvanatha.



- ✓ The birth anniversary of 24th and last Jain Tirthankar Lord Mahavir was celebrated across the country on **17 April**.
- The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has directed the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MoEF) to submit a report on the constitution of Biodiversity Management Committees (BMC) at the local level in every state within three months.
 - ✓ A bench headed by NGT Chairperson Justice Adarsh Kumar Goel also asked the states who have not constituted the committees to file an affidavit stating the reason for the delay.
- The Ministry of Ayurveda, Yoga and Naturopathy, Unani, Siddha and Homoeopathy (AYUSH), has signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR), New Delhi for cooperation in the field of research and education of traditional system of medicines and its integration with modern science.
- 20 States and Union territories have so far joined pan-India network of single emergency helpline number '112' launched as part of Emergency Response Support System (ERSS). This single number for emergency services is similar to '911' in United States.
 - ✓ Under it, all emergency numbers like 100 (police), 101 (fire), 102 (ambulance and disaster response) have been integrated into one single number '112'.
- The Indian Council of Medical Research has launched the 'Malaria Elimination Research Alliance' (MERA India) which is a conglomeration of partners working on malaria control in order to eliminate the disease from India by 2030.
 - ✓ The National Vector Borne Diseases Control Program (NVBDCP) of India has developed a comprehensive framework to achieve the target of "Malaria free India by 2030" and for this reason the Malaria Elimination Research Alliance (MERA) India established.
- The Union Ministry of Home Affairs has distributed around 3,100 special kits among states and union territories. The kits are termed The Sexual Assault Evidence Collection Kits (SAECKs) and are also called 'rape investigation kits' that help to collect blood and semen samples for carrying out immediate effective medico-legal investigations on sexual assault cases.
 - The SAECK kits are obtained only with the financial support under the Central government's 'Nirbhaya Fund', termed after the 2012 Delhi gang-rape victim.
- The largest construction agency of the central government, Central Works Public Department (CPWD) has set up an expert 8member committee under M K Sharma, CPWD's Additional Director General, Chairman for developing a design scheme to construct buildings and develop infrastructure.
 - ✓ The prime objective of this policy is to revive all levels of building construction and infrastructure development in CPWD, under the Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry.
- Supreme Court bench headed by Justice L Nageswara Rao has directed the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) to disclose information related to its annual inspection report of banks under the Right to Information (RTI) Act until and unless they are exempted under law. The bench has also directed the RBI to review its policy to disclose information relating to banks under RTI.
 - The bench was hearing a contempt petition filed by RTI activists Subhash Chandra Agarwal and Girish Mittal against the Reserve Bank of India.
- United Nations Children Fund (UNICEF) India and NITI Aayog's Atal Innovation Mission (AIM) has signed a Letter of Intent (LOI) to provide an open platform to promote participation, skill and empowerment among young children across different communities.
 - ✓ UNICEF: Headquarter: New York, United States,

- The Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (MOEFCC) notified that a committee will be formed to implement the National Clean Air Programme (NCAP) which was launched to handle the major issue of air-pollution in India. Overall guidance would be provided by the committee to implement and review the progress of NCAP for each financial year. The committee would be headed by its Secretary, C K Mishra.
 - ✓ Target: Reducing 20–30% of PM 2.5 and PM 10 concentration by 2024 taking 2017 as the base year for the comparison of concentration.
 - ✓ Coverage: It will be implanted in **102 identified non-attainment cities** for implementing mitigation actions under NCAP.
- The Fire Service Week is observed nation-wide from 14th April to 20th April. Since 1968, 14th April is observed every year as the National Fire Service Day in remembrance of the lives lost in the devastating fire that erupted and the explosions that followed on 14th April 1944 at freighter SS Fort Stikine at the Victoria Dock in Bombay Port. This year the National Fire Service Week was observed with a theme "Fire Prevention is better than Fire Fighting".

This comes this J&J product was tested positive for formaldehyde, which is harmful for the children in tests conducted in Rajasthan.






