


INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS

- India is elected to the Executive Board of the first UN-Habitat Assembly at the Plenary Session of the Assembly being held in Nairobi, Kenya. Theme:- "Innovation for Better Quality of Life in Cities and Communities".
 - ✓ UN-Habitat: is the United Nations programme working towards a better urban future. Its mission is to promote socially and environmentally sustainable human settlements development and the achievement of adequate shelter for all.
- The US Treasury Department has removed India and Switzerland from its currency monitoring watch list of major trading partners.
- As per 2019 edition of the IMD World Competitiveness Rankings, India is 43rd/63 most competitive economy in the world, India: has moved one notch higher to 43th rank (from its 44th position in 2018, 45th in 2017 and 41st in 2016.).
 - ✓ Singapore, Hong Kong SAR and USA are top three Economies in terms of competitiveness.



- The Quadrilateral Security Dialogue (Quad) meeting was recently held in Bangkok, Thailand for consultations on their collective efforts to advance a free, open, and inclusive Indo-Pacific region. It was attended by senior officials from US, Australia, India, and Japan.
 - ✓ Thailand: Capital: Bangkok,
- The 14th summit of the Organisation of Islamic Cooperation (OIC) held in Mecca, Saudi Arabia was hosted by Saudi King Salman bin Abdul Aziz Al Saud.
 - ✓ The summit, titled as "Mecca Summit: Together for the Future", aimed at developing a unified stance on events in the Islamic world.

- Currency: Saudi riyal. * The 2nd edition of Global Disability Summit was held in at Buenos Aires, Argentina from 6-8 June 2019. It is being organised by International Alliance Disability (IDA) and Latin American Network of Non-Governmental Organizations of Persons with Disabilities and their Families.
 - ✓ Deliberate on issues across the world concerning empowerment and inclusion of Persons with Disabilities (**PwDs**) and to work out mechanism for enabling them to live an independent and dignified life.
 - ✓ The 1st Global Disability Summit was held in London in July 2018.
- India was ranked at 95th among 129 countries in first edition of SDG Gender Index, a new index to measure global gender equality.
 - ✓ The Sustainable Development Goals Gender Index has been developed by UK-based Equal Measures 2030, a joint effort of regional and global organisations including African Women's Development and Communication Network, Asian-Pacific Resource and Research Centre for Women, Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation, and International Women's Health Coalition.
 - ✓ Denmark was ranked at the first place and Chad at 129th place. China ranked at 74 position, Pakistan at 113 while Nepal and Bangladesh at 102 and 110 respectively.
- UAE's Federal Authority for Identity and Citizenship (ICA) has issued the first Golden Residence Permit in Abu Dhabi.
 - ✓ It has been provided as a part of the **Investors Permanent Residence System** aimed to attract investors, entrepreneurs and qualified individuals who meet its criteria.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will visit Maldives and Sri Lanka from June 8 and June 9.






- The recent study "Traffic Index 2018", analysis of the current status of traffic mobility was conducted by location technology specialist TomTom.
 - According to the findings, Mumbai ranked first in the study among 403 cities in 56 countries with a congestion level of 65 percent, while New Delhi ranked 4th with congestion of 58 percent.

- Chandrani Murmu, a tribal woman, has made history after winning the Lok Sabha seat from Keonjhar in Odisha. She has become the youngest Member of Parliament (MP) at the age of 25 years and 11 months.





- ✓ The bank is actively participating in the government's flagship programmes including 'MUDRA' and 'Stand-up India' to provide the much-needed push to the MSME sector.
- The Market regulator Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) has proposed framework for Regulatory Sandbox for financial institutions for fintech testing in its recently released discussion paper.
 - ✓ Definition of **Regulatory sandbox**: It is defined as live, testing environment where new products, processes, services and business models can be deployed on limited set of eligible customers for specified period of time, with certain relaxations in the regulations and guidelines.



- ✓ Objective of sandbox: It is intended to serve as testing ground for new business models and technologies that benefits investors, Indian markets and Indian economy at large.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) constituted six member committee on Development of Housing Finance Securitisation Market. It is tasked to review existing state of mortgage backed securitisation in India and suggest ways to deepen housing finance securitisation market.
 - ✓ Composition of Committee: It will be headed by Bain & Co Senior Advisor Harsh Vardhan.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) is going to observe Financial Literacy Week across the country from 3rd to 7th June 2019. Theme of Financial Literacy Week 2019 : 'Farmers and how they benefit by being a part of the formal banking system'.
- The SWIFT India and South Asia Conference held at the St Regis Mumbai. The conference saw the participation of 500 delegates representing financial institutions, regulators, market infrastructure experts, multinational corporations, to discuss the most pertinent issues concerning the nation's financial market.
 - ✓ The theme of the conference was "Digitisation in transition: The future of innovation and cyber security.
- According to data released by World Gold Council (WGC), India has entered league of world's top-10 gold holding central banks. RBI currently holds 612.6 tonnes of gold as part of its foreign exchange reserves and was ranked 10th largest gold holding central bank. United States top this list, followed by Germany.
- The World Bank retained its forecast of India's growth rate at 7.5 per cent for the current financial year.
 - In its Global Economic Prospects report, the World Bank also said growth rate is expected to remain the same for the next two fiscals.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has approved the appointment of Rakesh Makhija as chairman of the Axis Bank.
- Industrial Credit and Investment Corporation of India (ICICI) launched a dedicated center in Bengaluru to provide hazel free services to small business owners and startups.

 According to the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT), the Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) in the services sector grew at 36.5% amounting to \$9.15 billion in 2018-19. Services sector comprises of finance, banking, insurance, outsourcing, R&D, courier, tech testing and analysis.
- In its 2nd bi-monthly monetary policy statement for 2019-20, the Reserve Bank India's Monetary Policy Committee (MPC) has unanimously decided to cut the policy reporte by 25 basis points and change the monetary policy stance from 'neutral' to 'accommodative'.
 - ✓ This is the third time successively that the six-member MPC has decided on a 25-basis points rate cut. The last time the RBI had to cut rates three times in a row wasin 2013.
 - ✓ Repo Rate: 5.75%,
 Reserve Repo Rate: 5.50%,
 Marginal Standing Facility (MSF)/Bank Rate: 6%.
- The Government has approved the reconstitution of National Institution for Transforming India (NITI) Aayog.
 - ✓ The Prime Minister will serve as the Chairman of Niti Aayog.
 - Vice-Chairman Rajiv Kumar continues in his post along with Permanent members VK Saraswat, Ramesh Chand and VK Paul.
 - ✓ The ex-officio members now include Defence Minister, the Home Minister, the Finance Minister and Agriculture Minister.
 - ✓ Special invitees to NITI Aayog include Minister of Road, Transport and Highways, Minister of Social Justice and Empowerment, Minister of Railways and Minister of Statistics.

CORPORATE AFFAIRS

- The National Company Law Appellate Tribunal (NCLAT) allowed the board of Infrastructure Leasing & Financial Services (IL&FS) declare 'amber' companies as 'green' companies.
 - The new board at IL&FS had classified IL&FS group companies into three categories, namely 'green', 'amber' and 'red' based on their financial health and ability to service debt obligations to secured and unsecured creditors.
 - Red Companies: are those with no cash and not in a position to pay any creditor.
 - Amber companies: are those with enough to pay secured creditors but not unsecured creditors.
 - Green companies: are those firms which have enough money to service all their debts, to the secured as well as unsecured creditors.



- Federation of Indian Chambers of Commerce and Industry (FICCI's) economic outlook survey projected India's median GDP (Gross Domestic Product) 7.1% for FY20 and 7.2% for FY21.

- The Oil and Natural Gas Corporation (ONGC) overtook India Oil Corporation (IOC) by regaining crown of being India's most ٠ profitable Public Sector Undertakings (PSU).
 - ✓ In fiscal year 2018-19, ONGC's net profits increased by 34% to Rs.26,716 crore in comparison to it IOC registered a net profit of Rs.17,274 crore for fiscal year ended March 31, 2019.
- Google and Amazon are under Scrutiny for their influence on consumer privacy, labor conditions, public discourse and * violation of antitrust law.
 - ✓ U.S. government's antitrust enforcement agencies, the Federal Trade Commissionand the Department of Justice are carrying out Antitrust Investigations against Amazon and Google respectively.
 - Antitrust law also referred to as competition laws aims to protect trade and commerce from unfair restraints, monopolies and price fixing.
- ** Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL), Bharat Petroleum Corporation Limited (BPCL) and Hindustan Petroleum Corporation Limited (HPCL) signed an agreement to form a Joint Venture (JV) in New Delhi for laying the world's longest Liquefied petroleum gas (LPG) pipeline from Kandla, Gujarat to Gorakhpur, Uttar Pradesh.
- ••• Ashok Leyland, Hinduja Group flagship firm, partnered with Suryoday Small Finance Bank to provide vehicle loans.

DEFENCE & SECURITY

- ٠ The Indian Air Force's (IAF) Flight Lieutenant Mohana Singh became first ever woman pilot to fly by day on Hawk advanced jet aircraft.
- An Anti-ship version of supersonic cruise missile BrahMos was successfully test fired from the Integrated Test Range (ITR) at Chandipur in Odisha. The test was conducted by Defence Research and Development (DRDO).
 - ✓ BrahMos Missile: It is joint venture between India (DRDO) and Russia (NIPOM). It is named after India's Brahmaputra and Russia's Moscowa rivers.
- The joint Indian Army, Air force exercise- Kharga Prahar was held in Punjab from May 27 to June 4, 2019. The week-long * exercise was undertaken by various units and formations of Kharga Corps.
- Indian Army has commissioned "Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring System (CAAQMS)" at its Eastern Command ** headquarter in William Military Station, Kolkata, West Bengal as part of its countrywide 'Go Green' initiative. It will monitor air pollution of city on real time basis and its readings will be considered a benchmark of quality.

SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY

- Union Ministry of AYUSH has launched 'Yoga Locator' mobile application to enable people locate yoga events and centres * providing training. It was launched ahead of the International Yoga Day observed every year on June 21.
 - Yoga Locator: It is map-based location app aimed at encouraging and helping people to adopt yoga.
- ••• The Indian Air Force (IAF) has signed an agreement with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) for crew selection and training for the prestigious Gangayaan, the country's maiden manned mission.
- * Indian Institute of Technology (IIT), Guwahati signed an MoU with the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) to set up an IITG-ISRO Space Technology Cell (STC) at the institute where Assam Governor Jagdish Mukhi inaugurated a new academic complex and research and development building.
- Facebook plans to launch its cryptocurrency by the first quarter of 2020. The company is expected to reveal more details about the currency before testing begins later in 2019.
 - ✓ The currency, which is being referred to internally as "GlobalCoin," will reportedly be available in around a dozen countries at launch, where it's expected to offer people affordable and secure payments without the need for a bank account.



- Delhi Metro has become the first ever metro project in the country to receive power generated from a waste-to-energy plant. It achieved this feat after receiving **2 MW power** from **12 MW** capacity waste-to-energy plant set up in **Ghazipur**. **
 - Recently an exhibition of art created by a humanoid AI robot, named Aida was held at University of Oxford.
 - ✓ Aida is the world's first ultra-realistic humanoid artist, able to draw creatively due toin-built artificial intelligence (AI) technology.
 - ✓ Ai-Da is named after Ada Lovelace, the English mathematician and writer often called the world's first computer coder.
 - In 2017, social robot Sophia was given citizenship of Saudi Arabia the first robot to be given legal personhood anywhere in the world.
- Army launched an online platform, Retired Officers Digital Records Archive (RODRA), https://rodra.gov.in with an aim to \Leftrightarrow have a better connection with armed forces veteran officers and family pensioners.
 - ✓ The website provides facilities such as updating records, registration, and tracking of documents and pension-related grievances and communicating regarding various issues.

SPORTS

- India is one of the 3 countries which have expressed interest to host the Asian Football Confederation (AFC)'s Asian Cup football tournament for Women to be held in 2022.
 - ✓ Chinese Taipei and Uzbekistan are the other countries in contention to host Asia's premier women's competition.
 - ✓ The three countries will now be invited to nominate their proposed venues for the tournament, with the host expected to be announced by the 2nd guarter of 2020.
- Gianni Infantino re-elected as President of Federation Internationale de Football Association (FIFA), a global governing body of football for second term.
 - ✓ **FIFA: Headquarter**: Zurich, Switzerland.
