




- The duration of the project is 23 months. It is financed by the **South Asia Food and Nutrition Security Initiative** (SAFANSI), administered by the **World Bank**.

- The Indian Navy is hosting Maritime Information Sharing Workshop 2019 (MISW 2019) under the aegis of the Information Fusion Centre-Indian Ocean Region (IFC-IOR) at Gurugram, Harayana. The two-day event was inaugurated by Vice Admiral MS Pawar, Deputy Chief of the Naval Staff.
  - ✓ Objectives: It was aimed at acquainting all participants about IFC-IOR and its information sharing mechanisms. It was also aimed at promoting and sharing best practices in this field for better yield response to myriad security and safety challenges faced by IOR.
- Directorate General of Training under the aegis of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship Ministry has joined hands with Cisco and Accenture to skill the youth for the digital economy through its Industrial Training Institutes.
- Arjun Munda, Union Minister for Tribal Affairs launched the "e-governance initiatives for ST Welfare schemes" at a function organized by Ministry of Tribal Affairs in New Delhi. Renuka Singh Saruta, Minister of State for Tribal Affairs
- National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA) is conducting a basic training programme at the Deendayal Port Trust in Kandla, Gujarat, aimed at increasing the awareness and enhancing the preparedness of Seaport Emergency Handlers (SEHs) to respond to CBRN (Chemical, Biological, Radiological and Nuclear) threats which emanate at seaports due to arrival, storage and transportation of a large amount of chemical, petrochemical and other CBRN agents.

It was organized with help of the Public Works Department (PwD) of Government of Maharashtra. The theme of this year's summit was "Transformation Strategies for Built Environment". This theme was adopted to focus on impact of incorporating sustainability initiatives into functioning public buildings.
- India will be hosting Intersessional meeting of Kimberley Process (KP) from 17<sup>th</sup> to 21<sup>st</sup> June, 2019 in Mumbai,
   Maharashtra. Along with it, meetings of different Working Groups and Committees of Kimberley Process Certification
   Scheme (KPCS), two special forums regarding Diamond Terminology and Artisanal Mining Small Steps to Larger Outcomes, will be also held.
  - ✓ It is international certification scheme that regulates trade in rough diamonds with aim of preventing flow of conflict diamonds, while helping to protect legitimate trade in rough diamonds.

### **INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS**

- India and Portugal have announced cooperation in the setting up of National Maritime Heritage Museum near ancient Harappans civilization at Lothal in Gujarat. It is likely to come up on the lines of a similar museum at Lisbon, which is administered by Portuguese Navy.
  - ✓ The foundation stone for proposed museum was laid by Prime Minister Narendra Modi in March 2019. It will be located near ancient Indian site of Lothal in Gujarat.


- Russian President Vladimir Putin has announced Russia was prepared to drop New Strategic Arms Reduction Treaty (New START) with the US. He said that Russia will not unilaterally extend New START with US as President Donald Trump administration has showed no genuine interest in conducting talks on extending the treaty.
  - ✓ It was aimed at capping the number of nuclear warheads of US and Russia well below Cold War limits.
- United Nation's Secretary General Antonio Guterres has praised India-UN Development Partnership Fund on its 2<sup>nd</sup> anniversary for championing greater prosperity for all while contributing to South-South cooperation. This initiative also has been held up by UN leaders as model for cooperation among developing countries.
- External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar will embark on a two-day visit to Bhutan.
  - $\checkmark$  This is Mr Jaishankar's **first overseas** visit after assuming charge of the Ministry.
  - ✓ Bhutan: Capital: Thimphu, Currency: Ngultrum.




- The United Arab Emirates (UAE) Cabinet adopted a National Strategy for Wellbeing 2031 during its meeting at Presidential Palace in Abu Dhabi (UAE Capital).
  - The strategy has two pronged objectives are- to make UAE a world leader in quality of life by undertaking various strategic objectives and initiatives and to promote an integrated concept of wellbeing, thereby supporting vision of UAE Vision 2021 and UAE Centennial 2071.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Maldivian President Ibrahim Mohamed Solih jointly inaugurated the coastal surveillance radar system built by India and a composite training facility of the Maldives National Defence Force in Male.
- Imports from Pakistan to India has declined by 92 per cent to 2.84 million US dollars in March this year after imposition of 200 per cent customs duties on all products following Pulwama terror attack.
  - ✓ India had revoked the MFN (Most Favoured Nation) status to Pakistan in the aftermath of the terror attack. It had granted the MFN status to Pakistan in 1996.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi has accepted an invitation from French President Emmanuel Macron to attend the outreach session of the G7 Summit in Biarritz as a special invitee.
  - ✓ The **45<sup>th</sup>** summit of the G7 group of countries will take place from August 24 to August 26 in Biarritz, France.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi's is on a two-day visit to Kyrgyzstan for SCO Summit at Bishkek, Kyrgyzstan.
  - $\checkmark$  The focus will remain on the sectors like pharmaceuticals, textiles, manufacturing and machinery.

Cyclone Vayu classified as severe cyclonic storm had developed into a cyclone storm from deep depression in Arabian Sea near Aminidivi island in Lakshadweep.

- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) eased regulations for Basic Savings Bank Deposit Accounts (BSBDA), popularly known as no-frills bank accounts. As part of the financial inclusion drive, RBI had asked banks to provide no-frills bank accounts as a savings account offering—certain minimum facilities, free of charge. "Banks are free to provide additional value-added services, including issue of cheque book.
- The Bank of Baroda (BoB) and ECL Finance, the flagship non-banking financial company of Edelweiss Group, signed an agreement to form a strategic partnership to explore co-lending opportunities.
  - ✓ BoB: Headquarter: Vadodara, Gujarat,CEO & MD: P S Jayakumar,Tag line: India's International Bank.


## **CORPORATE AFFAIRS**

- India has notified a Tax Information Exchange Agreement (TIEA) with the Marshall Islands. It will enable bilateral sharing of banking information and allow officials of one country to undertake tax examinations in the other. TIEA between India and Marshall Islands for exchange of information with respect to taxes was signed in 2016 at Majuro, the Capital of the Marshall Islands.
  - ✓ It will enhance mutual cooperation between India and the Marshall Islands. It will provide effective framework for exchange of information on tax matters which will help curb tax evasion and tax avoidance.
- The Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) has launched a Fiscal Performance Index (FPI) to assess state and central budgets.
  - ✓ The Index incorporates qualitative assessments of revenue expenditure, capital expenditure, revenues, fiscal prudence and the level of public debt arrive at a more holistic picture of fiscal performance than the fiscal deficit to GDP ratio according to the CII.
- Max Life Insurance Company launched a unique proprietary tool named 'My Protection Quotient' (MyPQ) to ensure financial protection in the country. Max Life Insurance Company is one of the fastest growing life insurance companies in India.

# **DEFENCE & SECURITY**

- Indian Air Force (IAF) has signed deal with Israel's Rafael Advanced Defense Systems to procure batch of advance bunker buster version of SPICE 2000 guided bombs at cost of Rs 300 crores. The order for bombs has been placed under special financial powers given to armed forces by the government for emergency purchases.
  - ✓ It is Israeli-developed, EO/GPS-guided guidance kit for converting air-droppable unguided bombs into precision guided bombs. SPICE stands for Smart, Precise Impact, Cost-Effective.
- A two-day 4<sup>th</sup> Subordinate Officers Conclave 2019 organized by Indian Coast Guard (ICG) was inaugurated by Rajendra Singh, Director General (DG) of ICG at ICG Headquarters in New Delhi.
  - ✓ The Indian and French air forces will carry out a two-week-long mega air exercise beginning July 1 in France.
  - A fleet of Sukhoi 30 fighter jets of the Indian Air Force will engage in dogfights with France's Rafale multirole aircraft in simulated scenarios as part of the 'Garuda' exercise.
- A major exercise, Kharga Prahar, was jointly conducted by the Indian Army and Indian Air Force (IAF) in Punjab.
- Indian Air Force (IAF) transport aircraft Antonov AN-32 that took off from Assam's Jorhat with 13 people onboard on June 3, 2019 went missing over hilly terrain in the Northeast. The wreckage of the same has been located by the IAF at 16 kms of North of Lipo at Siang district in Arunachal Pradesh.
- The Cabinet Committee on Security (CCS) headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi has approved proposal of setting up of the Defence Space Research Agency (DSRO). It has been entrusted with the task of creating space warfare weapon systems and technologies. The decision of creating DSRA was taken at topmost level some time ago and it has started taking shape under Joint Secretary-level scientist.
- India successfully launched new Hypersonic Technology Demonstrator Vehicle (HSTDV) off the coast of Odisha. Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) had carried out the trials from Dr Abdul Kalam Island in the Bay of Bengal.
