#### **NATIONAL AFFAIRS**

- The Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Central Silk Board on a convergence model for the implementation of Agroforestry in the silk sector. It is a part of the ongoing Sub-Mission on Agroforestry (SMAF) Scheme.
  - ✓ Earlier, the Government of India allocated **Rs. 2161.68 crores** for three years i.e. 2017-2020 to its **Central Sector Scheme 'Silk Samagra'** for the development of **sericulture in the country.**
  - ✓ **Aim:** To incentivize the farmers to take up sericulture based Agroforestry models thereby contributing to the Make in India and Make for the World vision of the Prime Minister.


#### Sub-Mission on Agroforestry (SMAF) Scheme

The **Department of Agriculture, Cooperation and Farmers Welfare** (DAC & FW) has been implementing the **SMAF** since 2016-17 as part of the recommendation of the **National Agroforestry Policy 2014**.

**India was the first country** to have such a comprehensive policy which was launched at the **World Agroforestry Congress** held in **Delhi** in February 2014.

The scheme is implemented only in the states having **liberalized transit regulations** for the **transport of timber** and will be extended to other states as and when such relaxations are notified by them. At present, the scheme is being implemented in **20 States and 2 UTs**.

- The Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways has flagged off an all-women crew onboard Shipping Corporation of India (SCI) vessel MT Swarna Krishna.
  - ✓ The initiative is a part of SCI's ongoing **Diamond Jubilee celebrations** and also to commemorate the **International Women's Day** (8th March).
  - √ This is the 1<sup>st</sup> time in the world maritime history that a cargo ship is being sailed by all women officers.
    - Launch: The TransUnion **CIBIL in partnership** with the **Ministry of Statistics & Programme Implementation** (MoSPI) has launched **MSME Credit Health Index**. The Index is published quarterly.
  - ✓ Aim: To provide a measure of the growth and strength of the MSME sector in India.
- Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) Floriculture Mission has been approved for implementation in 21 States and Union Territories of India.
  - ✓ CSIR's Societal Portal has also been launched along with the Android App.
  - ✓ Floriculture is a branch of horticulture that deals with the cultivation, processing and marketing of ornamental plants vis-à-vis landscaping of small or large areas, and maintenance of gardens so that the surroundings may appear aesthetically pleasant.
  - ✓ The mission will focus on commercial floral crops, seasonal/annual crops, wild ornaments and cultivation of flower crops for honey bee rearing.
    - The Indian floriculture market was worth Rs. 15,700 crore in 2018. The market is projected to reach Rs. 47,200 crore by 2024 during 2019-24.
- The birth anniversary of **Biju Patnaik** was celebrated (5<sup>th</sup> **March**). He is remembered as a **freedom fighter**, an Indian politician, an aviator and a businessman.
- ❖ According to information provided to the **Parliamentary Standing Committee on Water Resources**, only half of government schools and **anganwadis** have tap water supply, despite a **100-day campaign for 100% coverage** being launched by the **Jal Shakti Ministry** in October 2020.
  - ▼ The Committee also noted the progress of the flagship Jal Jeevan Mission.



- Governments around the world are exploring the potential use of vaccine passports as a way of reopening the economy by identifying those protected against the coronavirus.
  - ✓ A vaccine passport is an e-certificate that stores and records jabs and Covid-19 test status.
    - It can be kept in a smartphone app or in other digital formats.
    - Its contents can be flashed at security checkpoints when people travel across borders.
  - ✓ The World Health Organisation (WHO) is against the introduction of Covid-19 vaccination proofs as a requirement for international travel.
    - There are still critical unknown facts regarding the efficacy of vaccination in reducing transmission.

❖ The Centre government must increase the amount of pensions provided for poor senior citizens, widows and disabled people, said the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Rural Development.

Little Support | The National Social Assistance Programme is applicable to elders, widows and the physically challenged. Here is a low-down:

Pension: ₹200-₹500 a month for senior citizens BPL households

Widow Pension Scheme:
₹300-₹500 a month for widows aged over 40 in BPL households

Disability pension:
₹300 per month for persons aged 18-79 with severe or multiple disabilities in BPL households

The National Social Assistance Programme is a low-down:

₹20,000 upon the death of a breadwinner aged 18-59 in BPL households

Annapurna Scheme:
10kg of food grains per month for senior citizens who are not receiving any pension

#### National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP)

The **National Social Assistance Programme** (NSAP) is a welfare programme being administered by the **Ministry of Rural Development**. This programme is being implemented in **rural as well as urban areas**.

The programme was 1st launched on 15th August 1995 as a Centrally Sponsored Scheme. It was brought within the umbrella of 'Core of Core' schemes of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes (CSS) in 2016.

Currently, it has five components namely:

Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS) - since inception of NSAP in 1995.

National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS) - 1995.

Annapurna Scheme - launched in 2000.

Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension Scheme (IGNWPS) - launched in 2009.

Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme - launched in 2009.

- The Union Cabinet has approved the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Nidhi (PMSSN) as a single non-lapsable reserve fund for Health from the proceeds of Health and Education Cess.
  - ✓ The proceeds of Health and Education Cess are levied under Section 136-b of Finance Act, 2007.
- ❖ The Parliamentary Standing Committee on Education has recommended that all government schools start providing free breakfast in the coming academic year, as a part of an expansion of midday meal scheme envisaged by National Education Policy.
  - ✓ The National Education Policy identifies "providing food and nutrition" as one of the key long-term thrust areas for financing to cultivate a robust education system.
- The Prime Minister has flagged off a commemorative 'Dandi March' (on 12th March) to launch the celebrations of the 75th year of Independence 'Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav'.
  - ✓ The padyatra is being undertaken by 81 marchers from Sabarmati Ashram in Ahmedabad to Dandi in Navsari, a journey of 386 km. The march will end after 25 days, on 5th April 2021.
  - ✓ Descendants of those who walked the **Salt March** (in 1930) will be honoured.
  - ✓ Big events will be organised at six places associated with Gandhi. These include MK Gandhi's birthplace Porbandar, along with Rajkot, Vadodara, Bardoli (Surat), Mandvi (Kutch) and Dandi (Navsari).
  - ✓ **Cultural programmes** are planned at 21 spots on the route at the nightly stops for the walkers.
    - The **Dandi March**, also known as the **Salt March and the Dandi Satyagraha** was an act of nonviolent civil disobedience led by **Mohandas Karamchand Gandhi**.
    - The march lasted from 12th March, 1930 to 6th April, 1930 as a direct action campaign of tax resistance and nonviolent protest against the British salt monopoly.
- The Ministry of Power has launched "Energy Efficiency Enterprise (E3) Certifications Programme for the Brick Manufacturing Sector".
  - ✓ The E3 Certification Scheme is aimed at tapping huge energy efficiency potential in this sector.
  - ✓ E3 certification is an accreditation process focused on the **Brick industry**. The certification will be provided by the **Bureau of Energy Efficiency** (BEE).
- In order to facilitate the 'One Nation One Ration Card' system in the country, the Ministry of Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution has launched the 'Mera Ration' mobile app to benefit citizens in identifying the nearest Fair Price Shop (FPS).
  - ✓ This app will benefit especially those ration card holders who move to new areas for livelihoods.
  - ✓ The app is developed by the **National Informatics Center** (NIC).
  - ✓ **Language:** The application is currently available in English and Hindi.
    - However, it is planned to be introduced in 14 languages which will be identified on the basis of places where most migrant people move.
- Recently, the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA) has directed Nagaland, Manipur, Mizoram and Arunachal Pradesh to check illegal influx from Myanmar into India.
  - ✓ The instructions have also been given to **Border Guarding Force** (BGF), i.e. **Assam rifles.**
  - ✓ India already has a lot of **Rohingya** migrated from Myanmar.



- India, treats all refugees entering the country as illegal immigrants.
- In 2020, it was estimated that 40,000 Rohingya refugees lived in India, scattered across different states.
- Recently, the Union Road and Transport Minister announced the Vehicle Scrapping Policy in the Lok Sabha.
  - ✓ It was  $1^{st}$  announced in the **Union Budget for 2021-22.**
  - ✓ The policy is estimated to cover **51 lakh Light Motor Vehicles** (LMVs) that are **above 20 years of age** and another **34 lakh LMVs** above **15 years of age**.
  - ✓ India will also implement a **Global Positioning System** (GPS)-based toll collection system and do away with all toll booths within a year.
    - Vehicle manufacturers will also give a discount of 5% to people who will produce the 'Scrapping Certificate' and registration fees will be waived off on the purchase of a new vehicle.
  - ✓ **Aim:** Reducing the population of old and defective vehicles, bringing down vehicular air pollutants, improving road and vehicular safety.

- Recently, the **Government** has launched the **Gram UJALA Programme** an ambitious scheme offering the world's **cheapest LED bulbs in rural areas** at a mere **Rs. 10**.
  - ✓ Coverage: In its 1st phase launched from Arrah in Bihar, 15 million LED bulbs will be distributed across villages of 5 districts Aarah (Bihar), Varanasi (Uttar Pradesh), Vijayawada (Andhra Pradesh), Nagpur (Maharashtra), and villages in western Gujarat.
  - ✓ The **light-emitting diode** (LED) is one of today's most energy-efficient and rapidly-developing lighting technologies.

Other Schemes for Encouraging Use of LED Bulbs:

Unnat Jyoti by Affordable LEDs for All (UJALA).

Street Lighting National Programme (SLNP).

- The Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship has asked all government departments to ensure that workers executing government contracts must have official certification for their skills.
  - ✓ Initially, up to 10% of the strength of workers utilized in 2021-22 can be certified. This can be progressively increased to 100% by 2026-27.
- The Prime Minister of India paid tribute to Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia on his birth anniversary (23rd March).
- ❖ The Lokpal of India organized a Webinar on 'Bringing Synergies in Anti-Corruption Strategies'.
  - ✓ **Corruption** can be defined as the abuse of entrusted power for private gain. It can impact a nation's development in various ways.
- Centre is planning to introduce a 14-digit identification number to every plot of land in India within a year.
  - ✓ As per the **Department of Land Resources**, **Unique Land Parcel Identification Number** (ULPIN) scheme was launched in 10 states this year. **ULPIN** will be launched across India by **March 2022**.
  - ✓ Land parcel will be identified based on their longitude and land coordinates. This is the next step in DILRMP.
  - ✓ **Digital India Land Records Modernisation Programme** (DILRMP) was started in **2008**. It was extended several times. Now, the department has proposed further extension until 2023-2024.
  - ✓ NGDRS (National Generic Document Registration System) is also an initiative taken by Department under DILRMP.
- NITI Aayog released a report on 'Investment Opportunities in India's Healthcare Sector'. It includes investment opportunities in hospitals, medical devices and equipment, health insurance, telemedicine, etc.
  - ✓ **Healthcare** is one of the important sectors of the **Indian economy**. The **Healthcare industry** has been growing at the rate of **22% since 2016** and it is expected to reach **USD 372 billion in 2022**.
- Prahlad Singh Patel, Minister of State for Tourism and Culture, and Shivraj Singh Chauhan, Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh, inaugurated the Chhatrasal Convention Center under the Swadesh Darshan Scheme in Khajuraho.
  - ✓ They also launched "MICE Roadshow Meet in India" Brand and Roadmap for the Promotion of India as MICE Destination in Khajuraho. MICE stand for Meetings, Incentives, Conferences, and Exhibitions.
  - ✓ Ministry of Tourism, in association with the Madhya Pradesh government and India Convention Promotion Bureau, organized 'MICE Roadshow Meet in India' to promote India as MICE Destination.
- ❖ Dr. Harsh Vardhan, Union Minister for Health and Family Welfare, launched the "Tribal TB Initiative" to achieve the goal of "TB Mukt Bharat".
  - ✓ The Health Minister has also announced that the Lakshadweep and district of Badgam in Jammu and Kashmir have become TB Free.
  - ✓ Initiatives launched by the government for elimination of TB:
    - In March 2017, the Government of India had set a target to eliminate tuberculosis by 2025.

- In 2018, the government launched the Nikshay Poshan Yojana to provide nutritional support for TB patients.
- In 2019, the government launched the 'TB Harega Desh Jeetega' Campaign.
- ❖ Jal Shakti Abhiyan: Catch the Rain campaign will be launched by PM Modi on World Water Day.
  - ✓ 'Catch the rain, where it falls, when it falls' is the theme for this campaign. The campaign will be carried out in both rural and urban areas. It will start from 22 March and continue till 30 November.
  - ✓ On this occasion, a **Memorandum of Agreement** will also be signed between the **Minister of Jal Shakti** and the Chief Ministers of **Madhya Pradesh and Uttar Pradesh** to implement the **Ken Betwa Link Project**.
  - ✓ **Ken Betwa Link Project** is the 1<sup>st</sup> project of the **National Perspective Plan** for the **interlinking of rivers**. Under **Ken Betwa Link Project**, the water will be transferred from the **Ken to Betwa River** through the construction of **the Daudhan dam**.
- **Atal Innovation Mission**, NITI Aayog, and **Amazon Web Services** have collaborated to **strengthen the innovation** and entrepreneurship ecosystem in India.
  - ✓ The aim of the initiative will be to **empower school students** with **cloud computing skills** and enabling **entrepreneurs** to build innovative **education technology solutions** on the cloud.
  - ✓ A **Statement of Intent** (Sol) was signed between **NITI Aayog** and **Amazon Internet Services Private Limited** (AISPL), which undertakes the resale and marketing of **Amazon Web Services Cloud services in India**.
  - ✓ The students will be introduced to the fundamentals of cloud computing such as cloud storage, virtual computer power, web hosting, artificial intelligence, machine learning, and virtual reality at more than **7000 Atal Tinkering Labs.**
- Adhidhi Achyuth has become 1st transgender in India's fisheries sector to begin an entrepreneurial initiative.
  - ✓ Adhidhi Achyuth has got help from Central Marine Fisheries Research Institute (CMFRI) to open a fish vending stall in Kochi.
  - ✓ As part of the Central government scheme of the Scheduled Caste Sub Plan (SCSP), Rs 5 lakh were spent by CMFRI to set up fish stall.
- ♦ Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Bill, 2020 was approved by Rajya Sabha on 16 March.
  - ✓ **Lok Sabha** had already passed the **bill** in March 2020. Medical Termination of Pregnancy (Amendment) Bill, 2020 provides for a **limit of 24 weeks for medical termination of pregnancy**.
  - ✓ Currently, **abortion within 12 weeks** of conception requires the opinion of one doctor and abortion between 12 and 20 weeks requires the opinion of two doctors.
  - ✓ As per the new bill, abortion up to 20 weeks can be done on the advice of one doctor and abortion in the case of a certain category of women between 20 and 24 weeks requires the opinion of two doctors.
  - ✓ As per the new bill, the opinion of state-level medical board is required for abortion after 24 weeks in certain abnormal cases.
- ❖ Union Minister of Chemicals and Fertilizers, D.V. Sadananda Gowda, inaugurated the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of India Chem-2021 on 17 March 2021 in New Delhi.
  - ✓ It is being organised by the **Department of Chemicals and Petrochemicals and FICCI**.
  - ✓ The theme of India Chem-2021 is -"India: Global Manufacturing Hub for Chemicals and Petrochemicals".
  - ✓ It is one of the largest events of the chemical and petrochemical sector in the Asia-Pacific Region.
  - ✓ The objective of this summit is to promote the **small scale** as well as **large scale chemical industries** under the "Make in India" program.
  - ✓ Three different bilateral events will also be organised for enhancing trade and investment in the chemical sector. The bilateral events names are:
    - India-Japan Chemical and Petrochemical Forum.
    - India-EU Chemical and Petrochemical Forum.
    - India-US Chemical and Petrochemical Forum.
- **The government** has reconstituted the **Advisory Committee for multidisciplinary study of River "Saraswati".** 
  - ✓ The Committee has been reconstituted for 2 years. Culture Minister would chair this Committee.
  - ✓ The **Committee** has 27-members. It has officials from various ministries, representatives of ISRO, officials from the governments of Gujarat, Haryana and Rajasthan and an official from ASI.
  - ✓ The Committee also has archaeologists **B.R. Mani**, Vasant Shinde, K.N. Dixit and K.K. Muhammed, and historian Balmukund Pandey as its non-official members.
- The Information and Broadcasting Ministry had set up the Index Monitoring Cell (IMC) committee in 2020 for improving India's rank in the World Press Freedom Index.
  - ✓ Index Monitoring Cell (IMC) has submitted its recommendations for improving press freedom in India.
  - ✓ **Kuldeep Singh Dhatwalia** has chaired this **15 member committee**. Four journalists and 10 government employees are other members of the **Index Monitoring Cell** (IMC).
    - India's rank is continuously declining in the World Press Freedom Index.

- World Press Freedom Index 2020: It is released by Report without borders.
  - Norway has achieved the 1st rank in World Press Freedom Index 2020. India's rank is 142 among 180 countries.
- The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways has launched a new scheme for tourist vehicle operators. Under this scheme, any tourist vehicle operator may apply for an "All India Tourist Permit/ Authorization" online.
  - ✓ The Government has announced this scheme to boost tourism across the country. It will also help in increasing revenue for the states.
  - ✓ This new set of rules will be known as "All India Tourist Vehicles Authorization and Permit Rules, 2021". It will become applicable from 1 April 2021.
- ❖ Union Health Minister Dr. Harsh Vardhan addressed the inaugural session of 2<sup>nd</sup> edition TechBharat 2021.
  - ✓ **TechBharat 2021** is an e-conclave that brings together stakeholders from **Health Tech & Edutech sectors**.
  - ✓ **Udyog Bharati and IMS Foundation** organized the second edition of **TechBharat on a virtual platform.**
- The Women and Child Development Ministry has classified all schemes under 3 umbrella schemes Mission Poshan 2.0, Mission Vatsalya and Mission Shakti.
  - ✓ This step has been taken for the effective implementation of various programmes of the Ministry of Women and Child Development.
  - ✓ **Mission Poshan 2.0**: It has been announced in the **Union Budget of 2021-22**. All supplementary nutrition programme will be merged into **Mission Poshan 2.0**. It aims for improving the **Nutritional status of children**, adolescent girls, pregnant women and lactating mothers.
  - ✓ Mission Vatsalya: All programmes related to child protection services and child welfare services will be merged under it. The Government has allocated Rs 900 crores for Mission Vatsalya in the Budget 2021-2022.
  - ✓ Mission Shakti: All schemes associated with the protection and empowerment of women will be merged into it. Schemes like one stop centre, women's helpline, Beti Bachao Beti Padhao, Pradhan Mantri Matru Vandana Yojana will now be covered under the Mission Shakti.
- **❖** The government has set up a high-level national committee to commemorate the 75 years of India's Independence in 2022.
  - ✓ The national committee comprises 259 members, and it will be headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.
  - ✓ The committee will give the guidelines for the programs of celebration. The celebration will begin 75 weeks prior to August 15, 2022.
- Third Jan Aushadhi Diwas celebrations have started on 1 March, and they will continue until 7 March.
  - ✓ On this occasion, HEALTH Check-up Camps were organized by Jan Aushadhi Kendras all over India.
  - √ Theme of 3<sup>rd</sup> Janaushadhi Diwas is "Seva bhi Rozgar bhi".
  - ✓ Janaushadhi Diwas is celebrated every year. **Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India** (BPPI) is implementing agency of **Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana** (PMBJP).
  - ✓ "Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana" is an initiative by the Department of Pharmaceuticals, Ministry of Chemicals and Fertilizers.
- The Union Minister for Social Justice and Empowerment Thaawarchand Gehlot launched the "Sugamya Bharat App" for persons with disabilities. He also released a handbook entitled "Access The Photo Digest".
  - ✓ **Sugamya Bharat App** is developed by the **department of empowerment of persons with disabilities** (DEPwD) under the **Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment**.
  - ✓ It will act as a medium to enhance the accessibility for disabled peoples through 3 pillars of the Accessible India Campaign, i.e., built environment, transportation sector and ICT ecosystem.
- Prime Minister Narendra Modi will inaugurate the 'Maritime India Summit 2021' on 2nd March.
  - ✓ The 3-day summit will be organised by the **Ministry of Ports, Shipping and Waterways** on a virtual platform.
  - **✓ Denmark** is the partner country for Maritime India Summit 2021.

#### **INTERNATIONAL AFFAIRS**

- There has been an outbreak of **Equine Herpes Virus** (EHV-1) among **horses in Europe**.
  - ✓ So far 7 countries have confirmed EHV-1 cases: Spain, Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Sweden and Qatar.
- ❖ Indian Prime Minister held a Virtual Summit with the Prime Minister of Sweden to discuss bilateral issues and other regional and multilateral issues of mutual interest.
  - ✓ The Summit provided an opportunity to discuss the international situation and response to the Covid-19 pandemic as well as regional and global issues of mutual importance including climate action, sustainable development, gender equality, counter-terrorism and disaster resilient infrastructure, among others.
- The United Nations Development Programme (UNDP) in its latest report named "Protecting Women's Livelihoods in Times of Pandemic: Temporary Basic Income and the Road to Gender Equality" has proposed a Temporary Basic Income (TBI) for poor women in developing countries.
  - ✓ The proposal comes ahead of the **International Women's Day** (8th march) celebrations.

- ✓ **Gender Inequality: Unpaid Labor:** On an average, women spend 2.4 more hours per day than men on unpaid care and domestic work.
- 25 programmes offered by higher education institutions in India ranked among the top 100 in the world in their respective subject categories, according to the latest edition (11th) of the QS World University Rankings by Subject.
  - ✓ **Quacquarelli Symonds** (QS): It is a leading **global career and education network** for ambitious professionals looking to further their personal and professional development.
    - QS develops and successfully implements methods of comparative data collection and analysis used to highlight institutions' strengths.
  - ✓ Top Performers: **Globally Massachusetts Institute of Technology** (MIT -USA) and **Harvard** (USA) are among top performers, Russia and China record best-ever performances.
  - ✓ **India's Performance**: The 2021 QS's global university performance comparison offered independent data on the performance of 253 programs at 52 Indian higher education institutions, across 51 academic disciplines.
  - ✓ 12 Indian institutions that have made it to the top 100 of the world IIT Bombay, IIT Delhi, IIT Madras, IIT Kharagpur, IISC Bangalore, IIT Guwahati, IIM Bangalore, IIM Ahmedabad, JNU, Anna University, University of Delhi and OP Jindal University.
    - IIT-Bombay has cornered more top 100 positions than any other Indian institution.
- ❖ India expressed its intent to include Chabahar port in the 13-nation International North South Transport Corridor (INSTC) that extends from India to Russia, and to expand INSTC membership by including Afghanistan and Uzbekistan, at a "Chabahar Day" event organised as part of Maritime India summit.
  - ✓ This Summit saw participation from several regional officials including infrastructure Ministers from Afghanistan, Armenia, Iran, Kazakhstan, Russia and Uzbekistan.
- ❖ World Bank report named "Connecting to Thrive: Challenges and Opportunities of Transport Integration in Eastern South Asia" stated that seamless transport connectivity between India and Bangladesh has the potential to increase national income by as much as 17% in Bangladesh and 8% in India.
  - ✓ The report analyzes the Bangladesh-Bhutan-India-Nepal (BBIN) Motor Vehicles Agreement (MVA).
- \* Recently, the Prime Minister inaugurated Bharat Bangla Maitri Bridge in Tripura's South district.
  - ✓ The bridge 'Maitri Setu' has been built over the Feni river which flows between Indian boundary in Tripura State and Bangladesh.
    - Feni originates in the **South Tripura district**. The river passes through Sabroom town on the Indian side, and **meets the Bay of Bengal** after it flows into Bangladesh.
  - √ The 1.9 Km long bridge joins Sabroom (in Tripura) with Ramgarh (in Bangladesh).
  - ✓ The name 'Maitri Setu' symbolises growing bilateral relations and friendly ties between India and Bangladesh.
  - ✓ The construction was taken up by the **National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Ltd** at a project cost of **Rs. 133 crore**.
    - The National Highways and Infrastructure Development Corporation Limited is a fully owned company of the Government of India.
- Recently, the **Prime Minister** addressed the **1**<sup>st</sup> **summit of the leaders' of the** QUAD **(Quadrilateral Framework)**. The meeting was **hosted by the USA** on a **virtual platform**.
  - ✓ Earlier in February 2021, **QUAD ministerial meeting** discussed issues across **Indo-Pacific and the military** takeover in Myanmar.
  - ✓ QUAD is a grouping of India, USA, Australia and Japan which aims to safeguard the interests of democratic nations in the Indo-Pacific region and address global challenges.
  - ✓ **QUAD pledged** to promote a free, open rules-based order, rooted in international law to advance security and prosperity and counter threats to both in the Indo-Pacific and beyond.

QUAD: It is a 4-nation alliance of India, Australia, USA and Japan which was established in 2007.

It is often dubbed as an "Asian" or "mini" NATO, and is viewed as a counterbalance to China's military and economic clout in the Indo-Pacific region.

Interestingly, the QUAD, which used to be known as the quadrilateral security dialogue, is now known as the quadrilateral framework to indicate it has gone beyond a narrow security dialogue.

- ❖ Recently, in response to the backsliding of LGBTIQ rights in some EU countries, notably Poland and Hungary, the European Parliament has declared the European Union an "LGBTIQ Freedom Zone"
  - ✓ A majority of countries in the EU (23/27) recognise same-sex unions, with 16 legally recognising same-sex marriage.
  - ✓ LGBTIQ stands for Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Inter-sex and Queer.
- According to a recent report by **Stockholm International Peace Research Institute** (SIPRI) **India's arms imports** came down by a **3**<sup>rd</sup> (about 33%) between 2011-2015 and 2016-2020.
  - ✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> Highest Importer: India remains the 2<sup>nd</sup> highest importer, only behind Saudi Arabia.
  - ✓ **Arms Suppliers to India**: Russia is the largest arms supplier to India in both periods (2011-2015 and 2016-2020). However, Russia's share of Indian arms imports fell from 70% to 49%.

- France and Israel were the 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> largest arms suppliers in 2016–20. India's arms imports from France increased by 709% while those from Israel rose by 82%.
- The **USA became the 4**<sup>th</sup> **largest supplier** for the period 2016-20. It was the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest arms supplier to India in 2011–15.
- Recently, the President of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU) addressed Members of Parliament at the Central Hall of the Indian Parliament.
  - IPU is an international organisation of national parliaments. It was established in 1889 in Paris.
  - It was founded by statesmen Frederic Passy of France and William Randal Cremer of the United Kingdom.
  - ✓ **Aim:** To promote parliamentary dialogue world-wide and works for peace and cooperation among the peoples.
  - ✓ To promote democratic governance, accountability, and cooperation among its members.
- The **World Air Quality Report**, prepared by **Swiss organisation IQAir**, mentions that 22 of the top 30 most polluted cities globally are in India. The Report aggregated PM2.5 data from 106 countries.
  - ✓ **World Capital City Ranking**: Delhi has been ranked as the world's most polluted capital city followed by Dhaka (Bangladesh), Ulaanbaatar (Mongolia), Kabul (Afghanistan), Doha (Qatar).
  - ✓ World Country Ranking: Bangladesh has been ranked as the most polluted country followed by Pakistan and India.
    - The least polluted country is Puerto Rico, followed by New Caledonia, US Virgin Islands respectively.
  - √ **World City Ranking**: Hotan in China is the most polluted city with an average concentration of 110.2 μg/m³ followed by Ghaziabad in Uttar Pradesh.
  - ✓ **Indian Scenario**: Shows a boost in Delhi's air quality by approximately 15% from 2019 to 2020.
    - **Delhi** has been listed as the 10<sup>th</sup> most polluted city and the **top polluted** capital city in the world.
    - **Ghaziabad** is the 2<sup>nd</sup> most polluted city in the world followed by Bulandshahar, Bisrakh Jalalpur, Bhiwadi, Noida, Greater Noida, Kanpur and Lucknow.
- Recently, a new research conducted by **Pew Research Center** has found that the **coronavirus pandemic** has pushed about **32 million Indians** out of the **middle class** and increased **poverty in the country**.
  - ✓ The report is based on an analysis of World Bank data.
  - ✓ **Pew Research Center** is a **nonpartisan fact tank** that informs the public about the issues, attitudes and trends shaping the world.
    - The poverty rate in India likely rose to 9.7% in 2020, up sharply from the January 2020 forecast of 4.3%.

  - √ Top Performers:
    - Finland has been ranked as the happiest country in the world for the 4th consecutive year.
    - Followed by Iceland, Denmark, Switzerland, The Netherlands, Sweden, Germany and Norway.
  - ✓ Worst Performers:
    - Afghanistan (149) is the most unhappy country.
    - Followed by Zimbabwe (148), Rwanda (147), Botswana (146) and Lesotho (145).
  - ✓ India has been ranked 139, out of 149 countries evaluated.
  - ✓ In 2020, India was ranked 144 out of 156 countries surveyed.
- Recently, **US India Artificial Intelligence** (USIAI) initiative has been launched to scale up the **science and technology** relationship between **India and the United States**.
  - ✓ **US India Artificial Intelligence** (USIAI) is an initiative of **Indo-US Science and Technology Forum** (IUSSTF) which was established in March 2000.
    - The **Department of Science & Technology** (DST), Government of India, and the **U.S. Department of State** are respective nodal departments for **IUSSTF**.
- According to a new report released by the United Nations Children's Fund (UNICEF), one in 5 children worldwide reside in areas of high or extremely high water vulnerability.
  - ✓ The Report was released ahead of World Water Day (22<sup>nd</sup> March).
  - ✓ The new report is part of UNICEF's 'Water security for all' initiative that identifies areas where physical water scarcity risks overlap with poor water service levels.
  - ✓ The initiative aims to mobilise resources, partnerships, innovation and global response to identified hot spots.
  - ✓ Children in more than 80 countries live in areas with high or extremely high water vulnerability.
  - ✓ India has 4% of the world's freshwater which has to cater to 17% of the world's population.

• The report says that nearly 40% of the population will have absolutely no access to drinking water by 2030 and 6% of India's GDP will be lost by 2050 due to the water crisis.

  - ✓ **Nigeria, Bahrain** and India, which experienced the world's fastest-growing outbreak of Covid-19, were among the world's worst-performing countries in tackling inequality going into the pandemic.

  - ✓ The 1<sup>st</sup> day of the Meeting coincided with the **National Day of Pakistan** (marks Lahore Resolution of 23<sup>rd</sup> March, 1940).
- The International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) has declared African Forest and Savanna (or bush) elephants as 'critically endangered' and 'endangered' respectively.
  - ✓ Earlier, **African elephants** were treated as a single species, listed as Vulnerable. This is the first time the two species have been assessed separately for the **IUCN Red List**.
- **❖** The Earth Hour is being observed on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2021.
  - ✓ Earth Hour is the **World Wildlife Fund for Nature** (WWF)'s annual initiative that began in 2007.
  - ✓ It is held every year on the last Saturday of March.
  - ✓ It encourages people from more than 180 countries to switch off the lights from 8.30 pm to 9.30 pm as per their local time.
  - ✓ The idea is to refrain from the use of non-essential lighting to save energy in a **symbolic call for environmental protection.**
- ❖ Indian Defence Minister and his South Korean counterpart inaugurated the India-Korea Friendship Park in a ceremony at the Delhi Cantonment.
  - ✓ Later on both the ministers concluded a **bilateral meeting** and **explored different areas of cooperation**.
  - ✓ Earlier in February 2019, the **Prime Minister of India** visited **South Korea** (Republic of Korea).
    - The park has been developed in joint consultation with the Ministry of Defence, Government of India, Indian Army,
    - Delhi Cantonment Board, Embassy of Korea and Korean War Veterans Association of India.
- **❖ Japan** has finalised loans and a grant totalling around **233 billion yen** for several key **infrastructure projects in India**, including for a project in the **Andaman and Nicobar islands**.
- The Prime Minister of India paid a State Visit to Bangladesh to join the celebrations of the Golden Jubilee of the Independence of Bangladesh, the Birth Centenary of the Father of the Nation Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujibur Rahman and 50 years of establishment of diplomatic relations between India and Bangladesh.
  - ✓ Bangladesh thanked India for conferring **Gandhi Peace Prize for the year 2020** on Bangabandhu **Sheikh Mujibur Rahman.**
  - ✓ Jointly inaugurated the **Bangabandhu Bapu Digital Exhibition in Dhaka**.
  - ✓ To mark the 50th anniversary of India-Bangladesh friendship:
    - Both sides released respective commemorative postage stamps.

- Decided to commemorate 6<sup>th</sup> December as **Maitri Diwas**, the day when India recognized Bangladesh in the year 1971. India announced the establishment of the Bangabandhu Chair at the University of Delhi.
- Global Wind Report 2021 released by Global Wind Energy Council.
  - √ The 16<sup>th</sup> edition of the annual report of the Global Wind Energy Council has been released before the conference of COP26.
  - ✓ According to a new report by the **Global Wind Energy Council** (GWEC), the capacity to **generate electricity from wind** jumped by **53 percent in 2020**.
  - ✓ In 2020, **93 gigawatts** (GW) capacity was installed. Reports show this is not sufficient for the world to reach a 'net zero' emission status by 2050.
  - ✓ According to the report, the world needs to install a minimum of **180 GW** of new wind power capacity every year.
  - ✓ China and the USA were the largest Installers of Wind Power in 2020. Both installed 75% of the total Wind Energy installed in 2020.
  - ✓ Around the world, presently, a total of 743 GW of wind energy capacity has been installed.
- **❖ World Bank Group** has released its flagship report, **World Development Report**, for the year 2021.
  - ✓ The report is titled "World Development Report 2021: Data for Better Lives". It is about changing the potential of the data landscape to improve the lives of poor people.
- ❖ External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar will attend the 9<sup>th</sup> Ministerial Conference of Heart of Asia Istanbul Process (HoA-IP) on Afghanistan in Dushanbe. He is on a three-day visit to Tajikistan.
  - ✓ The main aim of this conference is to bring regional and international consensus for Afghan peace.
  - ✓ India is a key stakeholder for the peace, prosperity and stability in Afghanistan. India has started a dedicated Air Freight Corridor between **India and Afghanistan** and made efforts to integrate with Afghanistan.
  - ✓ S Jaishankar also visited the **Dushanbe-Chortut Highway Project site**.
- Norway is going to build World's 1st ship tunnel.
  - ✓ The tunnel will be constructed under the **mountains in Norway's Stadhavet peninsula**. It will be 1,700 meters long, 37 meters high and 26.5 meters wide.
  - √ The construction of the tunnel has to start in 2022 and will be completed by 2025 or 2026.
  - ✓ It will be constructed at an estimated cost of \$315 million.
- India has been ranked 40th in the recently released International Intellectual Property Index 2021.
  - ✓ It is annually released by the US Chamber of Commerce Global Innovation Policy Centre (GIPC).
  - ✓ It evaluates the **Intellectual Property rights** in **53 global economies**. It evaluates patent and copyright policies, commercialization of IP assets and ratification of international treaties of a country.
  - ✓ The US, the UK, Germany, France and Japan are the top five economies on the intellectual property index 2021.
- ❖ India's ranking in the latest global house price index has declined by 13 spots and it was in the 56<sup>th</sup> position in December 2020.
  - ✓ Knight Frank's Global House Price Index tracks how more than 50 mainstream national housing markets around the world performed.
  - ✓ Turkey continues to lead the annual Global House Price Index rankings. It is followed by New Zealand and Slovakia.
- Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) has announced to hold 'Pabbi-Antiterror-2021' exercise.
  - ✓ **Pabbi-Antiterror-2021** will be a joint **anti-terrorism exercise**. **India, Pakistan and China** will participate in this exercise.
  - ✓ The decision to hold **Pabbi-Antiterror-2021** was announced during the **36**<sup>th</sup> meeting of the **Council of the Regional Anti-Terrorist Structure** (RATS) in **Tashkent**, **Uzbekistan**.
  - ✓ **RATS** is a permanent organ of SCO. It is headquartered in **Tashkent**. **Next meeting of RATS SCO** will take place in September in **Uzbekistan**.
- **European Union** has now become part of **India's Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure** (CDRI) initiative.
  - ✓ EU says that the objectives of the **European Green Deal** and the recently adopted **EU Strategy on Adaptation** are aligned with CDRI.
  - ✓ **Coalition for Disaster Resilient Infrastructure** (CDRI) initiative:
    - The initiative was launched by **Prime Minister Narendra Modi** on 23 September 2019 at the UN Climate Change Summit.
    - It is a voluntary organisation that aims to promote **disaster risk and climate-resilient** new and existing infrastructure systems. Its headquarters is located in **New Delhi**.
- UNESCO has joined with Toonz Media Group and USO India in order to do water conservation awareness programme for students.
  - ✓ On the occasion of **World Water Day** (March 22), animation videos created by students will be released as part of H2Ooooh! Waterwise Program for school students.

  - ✓ The joint declaration highlighted the shared IBSA goals and commitments for achieving gender equality.
  - ✓ The **India-Brazil-South Africa** (IBSA) is a unique platform. It brings together three large democracies and major economies from three different continents.
  - ✓ IBSA Women's Forum is one of the 6 People-to-People Forums under IBSA.
- The Indo-US Science and Technology Forum (IUSSTF) has launched the US India Artificial Intelligence (USIAI) initiative on 17 March 2021.
  - ✓ It has been launched to enhance cooperation between both countries in the field of **Artificial Intelligence**.
  - ✓ The **U.S-India AI** (USIAI) initiative will identify the new areas of research and development and it will also give an opportunity for all stakeholders to share their experiences.
- **The world's largest floating solar** farm will be **constructed in Singapore**.
  - ✓ **Singapore** is one of the largest per capita carbon dioxide emitters in Asia. It is constructing the **world's largest floating solar** farm **for promoting renewable energy**.
  - ✓ Singapore government is aiming to increase solar energy use by four-fold times by 2025.
- ❖ Italy has signed the amended Framework Agreement of the International Solar Alliance (ISA) on 17 March 2021.
  - ✓ Recently, the International Solar Alliance (ISA) has amended the framework agreement to enable UN member states to join the group. After this amendment, countries outside the tropics can join the International Solar Alliance.
  - ✓ Harsh Vardhan Shringla and Italian Ambassador to India Vincenzo De Luca also discussed various issues, including the G20 Presidency and Vaccine Maitri.
- The United States has become India's 2nd-biggest oil supplier. It has replaced Saudi Arabia.

  - ✓ In the **Million Plus category of Municipal Performance Index 2020**, Indore (1st), Surat (2nd) and Bhopal (3rd) are the top 3 municipalities.
  - ✓ In the **municipalities with Less than Million population category** of Municipal Performance Index 2020, New Delhi Municipal Council (1<sup>st</sup>), Tirupati (2<sup>nd</sup>) and Gandhinagar (3<sup>rd</sup>) are the top three municipalities.

  - ✓ Bihar has already missed the **Kala-azar elimination target 4 times since 2010.**
  - ✓ The 1<sup>st</sup> deadline was 2010, under the **National Health Programme**, followed by 2015. It was later extended to 2017 and 2020 due to the government's failure to eliminate Kala-azar.
- ♦ India's biggest floating solar power plant by generation capacity (100MW) is being developed by the National Thermal Power Corporation Limited (NTPC) at Ramagundam in Peddapalli district of Telangana.
  - ✓ The project is in line with India's commitment to attain the target of 175 GW of installed **renewable energy** capacity by 2022 including 100 GW of solar installed capacity.
- ❖ The **Himachal Pradesh government** has decided to **start planting seabuckthorn** in the **cold desert areas** of the state. It's a shrub which produces an orange-yellow coloured edible berry.
  - ✓ In India, it is found above the tree line in the Himalayan region, generally in dry areas such as the cold deserts of Ladakh and Spiti.
  - ✓ A major part is covered by this plant in Himachal Pradesh, Ladakh, Uttarakhand, Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh.
    - The Seabuckthorn Plantation has many **Ecological**, **Medicinal and Economical benefits**.
- A pilot project RE-HAB (Reducing Elephant-Human Attacks using Bees) has been launched in Karnataka which entails installing bee boxes along the periphery of the forest and the villages to mitigate human-elephant conflict.
  - ✓ These spots are located on the periphery of Nagarahole National Park and Tiger Reserve, which is a known conflict zone.
- Recently, the **Kerala High Court** ordered the **Central government** to amend the **National Cadet Corps Act** (NCC Act) 1948 which excludes transgender persons from joining the National Cadet Corps (**NCC**).
  - ✓ Kerala was one of the 1<sup>st</sup> states in the country to formulate and implement a welfare policy for transgender persons in 2015.
    - The move followed the Supreme Court verdict in National Legal Services Authority v Union of India 2014 in which the right to equality and equal protection for transgender persons under articles 14, 15 and 16 was upheld and the bracket of a 'third gender' allotted to transgender persons.
- Recently, funds from **Members of Parliament Local Area Development Scheme** (MPLADS) were disbursed to the village panchayats of **Goa**.
  - ✓ Due to Covid-19 pandemic **MPLAD Funds Sch**eme is currently **suspended** and the disbursed funds were allocated earlier.
    - MPLAD is a Central Sector Scheme which was announced in **December 1993**.
    - Initially, it came under the control of the **Ministry of Rural Development**. Later, in October 1994, it was transferred to the **Ministry of Statistics and Programme Implementation**.
- Recently, the Government of Haryana has passed the Haraya Recovery of Damages to Property During Disturbance to Public Order Bill, 2021.
  - ✓ It can be noted that earlier **Uttar Pradesh Government** too had passed a similar **bill named** "Uttar Pradesh Recovery of Damages to Public and Private Property Act, 2020.
    - **Recovery of Damages**: The Bill provides for recovery of damages to properties caused by persons during disturbances to public order by an assembly, lawful or unlawful, including riots and violent disorder.

- Compensation to Victims: It also ensures compensation to the victims.
- **Comprehensive Coverage**: The recovery will not only be made from those who indulge in violence but also from those who lead the protest, the organizers, those involved in its planning and provide encouragement and the participants.
- Recently, the **Chief Minister of Rajasthan** announced the implementation of the **Rajasthan Model of Public**Health that would include a **Right to Health** as well as measures for preventive, primary and curative care as envisioned by the **World Health Organisation** (WHO).
  - ✓ The Mukhya Mantri Chiranjeevi Yojana will also be launched as a Universal Health Care scheme as part of measures to reinforce health infrastructure and ensure accessibility to all citizens.
    - The scheme stipulates cashless health services up to Rs. 5 lakh to every family in the State.
- The **Goa government** has limited the **Shigmotsav** (Shigmo festivities) parades to three locations only (Panaji, Ponda and Mapusa), owing to rising cases of Covid-19 in the state.
  - ✓ **Shigmo** is the celebration of a 'rich, golden harvest of paddy' by the tribal communities of Goa.
  - ✓ Agricultural communities including the **Kunbis**, **Gawdas and Velips** celebrate the festival that also marks the onset of spring.
  - ✓ Two Variants of the Festival:
    - Dhakto Shigmo: It is celebrated by the rural population, farmers and the labour class.
    - Vhadlo Shigmo: It is of greater importance and is celebrated by everyone.
- ❖ The Maharaja Chhatrasal Convention Centre has been inaugurated at Khajuraho, Madhya Pradesh.
  - ✓ The Convention Centre, named after the legendary **Bundelkhand King Maharaja Chhatrasal**, was built under the **Swadesh Darshan scheme** of the **Ministry of Tourism**.
- ❖ First Solar Lift Irrigation Scheme of Kargil Renewable Energy Development Agency (KREDA) was inaugurated by Ladakh Lieutenant Governor R K Mathur.
  - ✓ The scheme was inaugurated at Latoo Village, which is the last village on **Line of Control** (LOC).
  - ✓ In collaboration with **Ladakh Autonomous Hill Development Council Kargil**, KREDA has installed and commissioned a 41 HP Submersible Pump backed with a 50 Kw Solar Photovoltaic Plant.
  - ✓ This is the 1<sup>st</sup> prototype of the **Solar Lift Irrigation System** in Ladakh.
- Uttar Pradesh government has organised a 'Banana Festival' in Kushinagar from March 22 to 25.
  - ✓ It has been organised to promote the **One District One Product** (ODOP) scheme.
  - ✓ Around 4,000 farmers are associated with banana cultivation in Kushinagar. 3 banana fibre processing units and a **Common Facility Centre** (CFC) will also be established in **Kushinagar**.
  - ✓ The main aim of this banana festival is to support farmers and entrepreneurs engaged in banana cultivation.
- Union Power Minister R K Singh launched the GRAM UJALA scheme in Varanasi after launching in Arrah, Bihar, on 19 March.
  - ✓ Under this scheme, Convergence Energy Services Limited (CESL) will distribute high-quality LED bulbs at an affordable cost of Rs 10 per bulb in rural areas.
  - ✓ In the **first phase** of this scheme, around **1.5 crores LED bulbs** will be distributed across villages of **Aarah** (Bihar), **Varanasi** (Uttar Pradesh), **Vijaywada** (Andhra Pradesh), **Nagpur** (Maharashtra), and **Gujarat**.
- ❖ Indira Gandhi Memorial Tulip Garden in Srinagar has been opened for tourists. It is the largest tulip garden in Asia.
  - ✓ The tulip garden is spread over 30 hectares in the foothills of the **Zabarwan Range**. It is located along the bank of **Dal Lake**. It has 15 lakh tulips flowers of more than 64 varieties.
- ❖ Andhra Pradesh will launch India's 1st government-run animal ambulance network.
  - ✓ This initiative's main objective is to reach out to the distressed animals and provide them with proper animal healthcare.
  - ✓ CM YS Jagan Mohan Reddy further said that the Animal Husbandry Department would set up one Mobile Ambulance Veterinary Clinic at every assembly constituency.
- Uttar Pradesh government has launched the UP FPO Shakti Portal as part of the Kisan Kalyan Mission.
  - ✓ The **Department of Agriculture** has been developed the portal in association with the **Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation** (BMGF).
  - ✓ The main objective of this portal is to bring farmers, producer groups, traders and the **Department of Agriculture** at one platform.
  - ✓ It is the 1<sup>st</sup> fully dedicated **FPO portal for farmers**. It will enable farmers to download all necessary information to form **Farmer Producer Organizations** (FPO) in the state.
- ❖ Bihar has become the 1st Indian state to implement an ethanol promotion policy.
  - ✓ The policy would enable investors in directly preparing ethanol from maize, molasses, broken rice and rotten grains.
  - ✓ The policy was approved by the state cabinet. It was tabled in the Bihar legislature on 17 March 2021.
  - ✓ The **central government** permitted **direct production of ethanol** last December in agreement with **National Policy on Biofuels, 2018.**

- ✓ Government would give 15% subsidy to investors. The subsidy can be given only up to a maximum of Rs. 5 Crore.
- Pune's Blades of Glory Cricket Museum has become the world's largest cricket museum.
  - ✓ It has been awarded a 'World Record' by the World Record Academy.
  - ✓ Blades of Glory Cricket Museum was founded by **Rohan Pate**. **Sachin Tendulkar** formally inaugurated it in 2012.
  - ✓ It has more than 51000 cricket-related items and around 450 international cricket players have visited the museum.
  - ✓ It has beaten the Lords' Cricket Museum, the Bradman Museum, West Indies Cricket Heritage Centre and the New Zealand Cricket Museum in terms of collection of cricket related items.
  - ✓ It is also known as 'Castle of Cricket'.
- Chief Minister N. Biren Singh inaugurated Mai-Own 2021, an exhibition for local products of global standards in Imphal. The exhibition is being organised under the vision of "Atmanirbhar Bharat".
  - ✓ Chief Minister N. Biren Singh instructed the concerned officials to prepare a detailed report on which Department is helping which type SHGs and what products are being produced.
- **Jharkhand government** has approved a reservation policy for 75% reservation in private sector jobs for locals. It will be applicable for jobs with salaries up to Rs 30,000 per month.
  - ✓ Earlier, Haryana government has also approved 75% reservation for locals in private sector jobs with salaries below Rs 50,000 per month.
  - ✓ Andhra Pradesh is the 1<sup>st</sup> state in India to reserve 75% of jobs for locals in the private sector.
- The Uttar Pradesh government has organised a 3-day Kalanamak Rice Festival in the Siddharthnagar district. It was inaugurated by the Uttar Pradesh Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath.
  - ✓ Kala Namak rice is produced in Eastern Uttar Pradesh. It is also One District One Product (ODOP) of some districts of Uttar Pradesh.
  - ✓ The festival has been organised to promote the production and to provide a market for Kala Namak Rice.
- Tirath Singh Rawat becomes the new Chief Minister of Uttarakhand after the resignation of Trivendra Singh Rawat. Tirath Singh Rawat is the 1st Education Minister of Uttarakhand.
  - ✓ Tirath Singh Rawat has taken the oath as the Chief Minister in the presence of Governor Baby Rani Maurya.
- President inaugurated the conservation works of the Singorgarh Fort in Damoh district of Madhya Pradesh.
  - He also inaugurated Jabalpur Circle of Archaeological Survey of India and addressed the State Level Tribal Conference in Damoh.
  - ✓ On this occasion, **President** also launched the portal for virtual classes for **tribal artists** and a booklet of the **Tribal Department** was also released. President also gave **Shankar Shah and Rani Durgavati** awards to tribal students.
- UP Government will launch a campaign to prepare the golden cards of the Ayushman Bharat scheme and it will be given to families who have not yet benefited from the scheme.
  - ✓ The campaign will be launched all over the state with twin aims as given next.
    - Promote awareness about Ayushman Bharat Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB PM-JAY) and its benefits.
    - Enable rural beneficiaries and beneficiaries in remote areas to get cashless healthcare worth Rs 5 lakh per family per year.
- The Tripura government has launched the digital platform "Jagrut Tripura" to promote e-governance in the state. It has been launched by Chief Minister Biplab Kumar Deb.
  - It will help people in availing the benefits of various scheme of the Centre and the state government. Around 102 schemes will be available on this platform.
  - ✓ 'Jagrut Tripura' platform has been developed by EasyGov, a Jio Group company.
- On the occasion of International Women's Day, Culture Minister Prahlad Singh Patel has inaugurated the All-Women's Art Exhibition titled 'Akshya Patra'
  - ✓ More than 250 workers from 12 countries have participated in this Exhibition. It is scheduled to be organised between 8 March to 20 March.
  - ✓ It has given an opportunity to female artists from India and the world to showcase their work.
  - ✓ It is being organised by the Lalit Kala Akademi at Rabindra Bhavan in New Delhi.
- Gur Mahotsav or jaggery festival was celebrated in Lucknow. It was inaugurated by Chief Minister Yogi Adityanath.
- Outcome-based budget has been presented by the **[harkhand government** for the 1st time.
  - ✓ In this budget, the state government has given specific targets and responsibilities to the eleven departments.
- The 1st consignment of 'red rice' has been flagged off from Assam to the USA to promote the export of rice.
  - ✓ Iron rich 'red rice' is mainly produced in the area of Brahmaputra valley in Assam. It is produced without using any chemical fertilizer.
  - ✓ It is known as 'Bao-dhaan' in Assam. The export of 'red rice' will increase the income of farmers in Assam.
  - ✓ The government has set up the Rice Export Promotion Forum (REPF) to promote the export of rice. It works under the APEDA.

- ❖ Andhra Pradesh Chief Minister Y.S. Jagan Mohan Reddy announced the calendar for 23 Welfare schemes.
  - ✓ Andhra Pradesh government has approved the 'EBC Nestam' scheme for women in the Economically Backward Classes category. Under this scheme, women in the age group of 45-60 years would receive financial assistance of Rs 15,000 per annum.
  - ✓ The state cabinet has approved the implementation of the 'Navaratnalu' scheme for FY 2021-22. It is a combination of 9 welfare schemes.
  - ✓ Cabinet also gave its approval to implement the **Jagananna Vasathi Deevena scheme** for providing financial assistance to **BPL students**. It will be implemented in April, July, and December in 2021 and in February 2022.
  - ✓ The **Jagananna Vidya Kanuka scheme** will help in **providing school kits to the poor children of the state**. It will be implemented in June.
  - ✓ The state cabinet has also approved the implementation of various schemes such as Matsyakara Bharosa, Rythu Bharosa, Kapu Nestam, Netanna Nestam, etc.
  - ✓ The social welfare schemes like **YSR Law Nestam**, **Jagananna Goru Mudda**, **YSR Sampoorna Poshana** will also be implemented this financial year.

#### **ECONOMY AWARENESS**

- The latest MSME Credit Health Index indicates that MSME credit growth has accelerated in the quarter ending September 2020 as compared to the quarter ending in June 2020.
  - ✓ The Emergency Credit Line Guarantee Scheme (ECGLS) has helped in the credit growth for the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) sector.
- Recently, a sub-committee of the **Insolvency Law Committee** (ILC) has recommended a **pre-pack framework** within the basic structure of the **Insolvency and Bankruptcy Code** (IBC), **2016**.
  - ✓ The Government had constituted a sub-committee of Insolvency Law Committee (ILC) in June, 2020 under the chairmanship of Dr. M. S. Sahoo, Chairperson, Insolvency and Bankruptcy Board of India (IBBI) to make recommendation on Pre-Pack Insolvency Resolution Process (PPIRP).
  - ✓ A **pre-pack** is an agreement for the resolution of the **debt of a distressed company** through an agreement between secured **creditors and investors** instead of a **public bidding process**.
    - This system of insolvency proceedings has become an increasingly popular mechanism for insolvency resolution in the UK and Europe over the past decade.
- ❖ The Union Cabinet has approved the Production-Linked Incentive (PLI) scheme for the telecom sector with an outlay of Rs. 12,195 crores over 5 years.
  - ✓ **PLI Scheme**: In order to **boost domestic manufacturing** and cut down on import bills, the central government in March 2020 introduced a scheme that aims to give companies incentives on incremental sales from products manufactured in domestic units.
    - Apart from inviting foreign companies to set shop in India, the scheme also aims to encourage local companies to set up or expand existing manufacturing units.
- The **private companies** have shown interest in setting up **New Umbrella Entities** (NUEs) for payment systems an idea floated by the **Reserve Bank of India** (RBI).
  - ✓ The aim is to create an alternate mechanism to the existing National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI).
    - NUEs will be a **non-profit entity** that will set-up, manage and operate new **payment systems**, especially in the retail space such as ATMs, white-label PoS; Aadhaar-based payments and remittance services.
- Recent data released by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) showed that Bank credit and deposits grew and were higher in February 2021 than January 2021.
  - ✓ The **credit and deposits** for February 2021 were even higher than the pre-pandemic data of February 2020.
  - ✓ Bank Related Data by RBI: At the end of February 2021:
    - Bank credit grew by **6.63% to Rs.107.75 lakh crore** which in February 2020 stood at **Rs.101.05 lakh crore**.
    - Bank deposits grew by 12.06% to Rs.149.34 lakh crore which in February 2020 stood at Rs.133.26 lakh crore.
- Recently, the Office of the Economic Adviser, **Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade** has released the **Wholesale Price Index** (WPI) for the month of February, 2021.
  - ✓ Wholesale Price-Inflation: It increased for the second consecutive month to 4.17%.
    - This is the highest since November 2018, when wholesale inflation was at 4.47%.
    - The WPI inflation was 2.03% in January 2021 and 2.26% in February 2020.
  - ✓ The base year of **All-India WPI** has been revised from 2004-05 to 2011-12 in 2017.
- The Reserve Bank of India (RBI) has decided to conduct simultaneous purchase and sale of government securities (G-Sec) under Open Market Operations (OMOs) for an amount of Rs. 10,000 crore each.
  - ✓ Simultaneous purchase and sale of government securities under OMOs, popularly known as operation twist, involves purchasing G-Sec of longer maturities and selling equal amounts of G-Sec of shorter maturities.

- The Supreme Court flagged the possibility of misuse of money received by political parties through electoral bonds for ulterior objects like funding terror or violent protests.
  - ✓ The court also asked the government **whether there is any "control"** over how these donations were used by political parties.

**Electoral Bond:**- Electoral Bond is a **financial instrument** for making **donations to political parties**.

The **bonds are issued in multiples** of Rs. 1,000, Rs. 10,000, Rs. 1 lakh, Rs. 10 lakh and Rs. 1 crore without any maximum limit.

**State Bank of India** is authorised to issue and encash these bonds, which are valid for fifteen days from the date of issuance. These bonds are redeemable in the designated account of a registered political party.

The bonds are available for purchase by any person (who is a citizen of India or incorporated or established in India) for a **period of ten days** each in the months of January, April, July and October as may be specified by the Central Government.

- The Rajya Sabha cleared the National Bank for Financing Infrastructure and Development (NBFID) Bill, 2021.
  - ✓ The Bill seeks to establish the **National Bank for Financing Infrastructure and Development** (NBFID) as the principal **Development Financial Institution** (DFIs) for **infrastructure financing**.
  - ✓ NBFID was announced in the Budget 2021.
  - ✓ NBFID will be set up as a corporate body with authorised share capital of one lakh crore rupees.
  - ✓ **Aim:** To directly or indirectly lend, invest, or attract investments for infrastructure projects located entirely or partly in India.
- **Standing External Advisory Committee** has been set up by RBI to evaluate **on-tap applications for universal and** small finance banks.
  - ✓ RBI's former deputy governor, Shyamala Gopinath, is head of the Standing External Advisory Committee.
  - ✓ In addition to the chairperson, the committee has 4 other members also. The names of four other members are given below.
    - RBI central board director Revathy Iyer
    - NPCI chairman B Mahapatra
    - Canara Bank's former chairman T N Manoharan
    - SBI's former MD & PFRDA's former chairman Hemant Contractor
- SBI and Indian Oil Corporation Limited (IOCL) have signed a \$100 million deal by using the new Secured Overnight Financing Rate (SOFR) in the external commercial borrowing (ECB) market.
  - ✓ It is the 1<sup>st</sup> deal with the **Secured Overnight Financing Rate** (SOFR).
  - ✓ **Secured Overnight Financing Rate** (SOFR) is a secured **interbank overnight interest rate**. It will replace the existing benchmark rate LIBOR (**London Interbank Offered Rate**).
  - ✓ **London Inter-bank Offered Rate** (LIBOR) is a benchmark rate for various financial instruments. It will be discontinued from December 2021.
  - ✓ Recently, ICICI Bank has carried out its 1st Secured Overnight Funding Rate (SOFR)-linked interbank-money market transaction.
  - ✓ **External commercial borrowing** (ECB): It is a financial instrument to borrow money from a foreign source. It is used by Indian corporations and PSUs to borrow money in foreign currency.
- The Union Cabinet has approved a bill to set up a Development Finance Institute (DFI) with an initial capital of Rs. 20,000 crore.
  - ✓ The bill will be presented in Parliament during the current Budget Session. DFI will raise long-term funds for infrastructure development projects in India.
  - ✓ As per Finance Minister **Nirmala Sitharaman**, **Rs 5,000 crore** will be the initial grant to the DFI. She further said that additional increments of the grant would be made within the limit of Rs 5,000 crores.
  - ✓ A DFI is an institution that provides development finance to sectors or sub-sectors of the economy. **Industrial Finance Corporation of India** was the **1**st **DFI**. **It was established in 1948**.
- Insurance Regulatory and Development Authority of India (IRDAI) has formed 14-membered Committee to review its Information & Cyber security Guidelines.
  - ✓ **Institute for Development and Research in Banking Technology** (IDRBT) Chairman **D Janakiram** is the head of this committee. **A R Nithiyanantham** is its convenor. The Committee will submit its report in 2 months.
  - ✓ Guidelines on information and cyber security for insurers were issued by IRDAI in April 2017.
- SBI is at the top of the list of the Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology's, Digital Payment Scorecard for 3 consecutive months.
  - ✓ SBI recorded the highest **UPI transaction volume**. It recorded nearly **64 crores** (640 million) **UPI transactions** despite having a user base of **13.5 crores**.
  - ✓ The number of UPI transactions processed by SBI through its digital platforms is 636 crore. It is about 67% of transactions of SBI's total transaction volume.

- ✓ SBI's market share by transaction volume of mobile banking is **25**%. SBI's digital platform **YONO** disbursed more than **10 lakh personal loans** during April-December 2020.
- National Payments Corporation of India (NPCI) has partnered with SBI Payments to launch 'RuPay SoftPoS'.
  - ✓ It will transform an NFC-enabled smartphone into merchant Point of Sale (PoS) terminals for the merchants.
  - ✓ It will enable **merchants to perform transactions** of up to **Rs 5,000** through their **smartphones**.
  - ✓ It will provide a cost-effective infrastructure for merchants to promote contactless digital transactions.

- The Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India (BPPI) celebrated the 3<sup>rd</sup> Janaushadhi Diwas (7<sup>th</sup> March 2021) to spread awareness about quality generic medicines, available at low prices.
  - ✓ Theme of **Janaushadhi Diwas** was "**Seva Bhi Rozgar bhi**". The Janaushadhi week was celebrated across the country from 1st-7th March 2021.
  - ✓ As a part of celebrations, the **Prime Minister** inaugurated the **7,500**<sup>th</sup> **Janaushadhi Kendra** at NEIGRIHMS, Shillong.

#### Pradhan Mantri Bhartiya Janaushadhi Pariyojana (PMBJP)

PMBJP is a campaign launched by the **Department of Pharmaceuticals in 2008** under the name **Jan Aushadhi Campaign**. The campaign was revamped as **PMBJP in 2015-16**.

Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India (BPPI) is the implementation agency for PMBJP.

The Bureau of Pharma PSUs of India works under the Ministry of Chemicals & Fertilizers.

BPPI has also developed the Janaushadhi Sugam Application.

- The Energy and Resources Institute (TERI) and Shell have released a report titled "India: Transforming to a Net-Zero Emissions Energy System".
  - ✓ It illustrates a pathway to steer the domestic energy system towards **net-zero emissions by 2050**, while achieving **India's sustainable economic development ambitions**.
  - ✓ 'Net zero emissions' refers to achieving an overall balance between greenhouse gas emissions produced and greenhouse gas emissions taken out of the atmosphere.
  - ✓ 1<sup>st</sup>, human-caused emissions (like those from fossil-fueled vehicles and factories) should be reduced as close to zero as possible. 2<sup>nd</sup>, any remaining **GHGs** should be balanced with an equivalent amount of **carbon removal**, for example by restoring forests.
- Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (POWERGRID) launched an e-tendering Portal, 'PRANIT'.
  - ✓ It has been launched for ease of operation and to bring transparency in the tendering process.
  - ✓ It has been approved by the Standardisation, **Testing and Quality Certification Directorate** (STQC) of the **Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology**.
- ReNew Power is the world's 1st clean energy company to be added to the World Economic Forum's Global Lighthouse Network of Companies.
  - ✓ **ReNew's Hubli facility** was specifically nominated to **Global Lighthouse**. **Mr. Sumant Sinha** is the founder and CEO of ReNew Power.
  - ✓ World Economic Forum's Global Lighthouse Network of Companies recognizes the companies leading in the area of technology-Enabled, Sustainable Growth.

  - ✓ It has been launched as part of the **Google Internet Saathi programme**. It will help in increasing the contribution of women to the economy of the country.
  - ✓ The **Internet Saathi Programme** was launched by **Google in 2015** to impart digital literacy training to women across villages.
- ❖ The **Western Railway zone** of the **Indian Railways** has introduced the **Mobile Train Radio Communication** (MTRC) system on 1 March 2021.
  - ✓ It will facilitate a better communication system between the train crew and the control centre and the station master. It is an effective and advanced method for communication.
- **♦ Mumbai's Chhatrapati Shivaji Maharaj Terminus** becomes the 1<sup>st</sup> railway station to get IGBC (**Indian Green Building Council**) **Gold Certification in Maharashtra**.
  - ✓ It has also become the **1**<sup>st</sup> **railway station** of the western division to get IGBC Gold Certification.
  - ✓ CSMT implemented various green and passenger-friendly initiatives, including the installation of solar panels, plantation of trees, Smart-tech amenities for passengers, Divyangjan and senior citizen-friendly building, etc.
- Lok Sabha TV and Rajya Sabha TV have been merged into one channel, which will now be known as Sansad TV.
  - ✓ The plan of merger was proposed by an expert committee headed by **Surva Prakash in 2019**.
  - ✓ Ravi Capoor has been appointed as the Chief Executive Officer of 'Sansad TV' for one year.
  - ✓ **Sansad TV** will telecast the proceedings of Upper and Lower Houses on two different channels.
  - ✓ Lok Sabha TV was launched in 2006, while Rajya Sabha TV was launched in 2011.

- The Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) has successfully conducted the test of the Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet (SFDR) technology, which is crucial for the indigenous development of long range air-to-air missiles.
  - ✓ Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet (SFDR) Technology:
    - SFDR technology is a missile propulsion system based on the concept of Ramjet Engine principle.
    - The system utilises a solid fuelled air-breathing ramjet engine.
- **❖ Multi billion** deals for **armed** drones **from the USA** and advanced **submarines under Project-75I** are to be taken by the **Defence Acquisition Council** (DAC).
  - ✓ **India** has been looking to procure 30 armed drones, 10 for each service, from the USA but the process has been repeatedly delayed over the last couple of years.
- The **Defence Research and Development Organisation** (DRDO) has conducted the final development test of **Air Independent Propulsion** (AIP) System, crucial for **diesel electric submarines**.
- Recently, the 2<sup>nd</sup> edition of India-Uzbekistan joint military exercise "Dustlik-2" started in Chaubatia, Uttarakhand.
  - ✓ **Aim of the Exercise: Counter Insurgency** (CI) and **Counter Terrorism** (CT) operations in mountainous, rural and urban scenarios under the **United Nations** (UN) mandate.
    - About the 1st Edition: Took place in Tashkent, Uzbekistan in November 2019.
- Recently, Indian Navy's 3<sup>rd</sup> stealth Scorpene class (of Project-75) Submarine INS Karanj has been commissioned at the Naval Dockyard Mumbai.
  - ✓ **Project 75:** It is a programme by the **Indian Navy** that entails **building six Scorpene Class** attack submarines.
    - It is given support by the **Department of Defence Production** (Ministry of Defence) and **Indian Navy** throughout its various phases of construction.
  - **✓** Other Submarines of the Ongoing Project-75:
    - Two submarines, Kalvari and Khanderi, have been commissioned into the Indian Navy.
    - The 4th Scorpene, Vela, has commenced its sea trials.
    - The 5th Scorpene 'Vagir' was launched in November 2020.
    - The 6th and last submarine, **Vagsheer**, is being readied for boot together.
- ❖ Special Forces of India and the USA conducted the joint military exercise 'VAJRA PRAHAR 2021' in Himachal Pradesh.
  - ✓ Earlier, India and the USA navy had carried out a 2-day Passage Exercise (PASSEX) in the eastern Indian Ocean Region.
  - ✓ This is the 11<sup>th</sup> edition of the exercise conducted at Special Forces Training School located at Bakloh, Himachal Pradesh.
    - The 10th edition of VAJRA PRAHAR was held in 2019 at Seattle, USA.

  - ✓ After the 'La Pérouse' joint exercise, Varuna naval exercise between India and France will be held. This year the United Arab Emirates will also participate in this exercise
- ❖ Indian Coast Guard ship 'Vajra' has been commissioned into service for enhancing coastal security capability.
  - ✓ It is designed and built by **Larsen and Toubro Ship building Limited** at **Kattupalli, Chennai**. It is the 6<sup>th</sup> in the series of **7 offshore patrol vessels** to be constructed by **Larsen & Toubro Ltd**.
    - Earlier, an indigenously built Coast Guard ship 'Sujeet' has been commissioned at Goa.
- According to a study by the defence website 'Military Direct', the Chinese Military is the strongest military force in the world. **USA** is in second place, followed by **Russia** in 3<sup>rd</sup> place.
  - ✓ **India** with 61 points has been ranked in  $4^{th}$  place, it is followed by **France** with 58 points. The **U.K.** is in the  $9^{th}$  position with a score of 43.
- ❖ Indian Army has decommissioned the 130mm Self Propelled M-46 Catapult Guns and the 160mm Tampella Mortars from service at Mahajan Field Firing Ranges.
  - ✓ The decommissioning ceremony was attended by Lieutenant General K Ravi Prasad, Director General Artillery.
- ❖ India successfully conducted a flight test of **Solid Fuel Ducted Ramjet** (SFDR) technology from **Integrated Test Range** (ITR) **Chandipur**.
  - ✓ **SFDR technology** will enable the **DRDO to develop** long-range **air-to-air missiles**. In the world, only a few countries have developed this technology.
- ❖ Indian Army has started its community Radio Station "Radio Chinar 90.4, Har Dil Ki Dhadkan" in Sopore of Baramulla district.
- ❖ 1st time, the Indian Air Force will participate in the 'Exercise Desert Flag-06' at Al-Dhafra airbase in UAE.
  - ✓ Exercise 'Desert Flag' is an annual warfare exercise of the United Arab Emirates Air Force.
  - ✓ Air Force of United Arab Emirates, United States of America, France, Saudi Arabia, South Korea and Bahrain will also participate in this exercise.

#### **SCIENCE & TECHNOLOGY**

- Forty scholars from six countries have been recommended for award of Indian Science Research Fellowship (ISRF) 2021.
  - ✓ This fellowship is a platform to establish research cooperation with neighbouring countries of India, which is one of the mandates of Department of Science and Technology (DST) International Science and Technology Cooperation.

#### India Science Research Fellowship (ISRF)

As part of **India's initiatives to engage** with **neighbouring countries** to develop S&T partnerships, the **Department of Science and Technology** (DST) has launched **ISRF Programme**.

This fellowship is for scholars from the neighbouring countries - Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka, and Thailand.

**ISRF programme** has provided an opportunity to the young researchers from neighbouring countries to get access to the state of art facilities available in the Indian institutes/universities. ISRF has been implemented since 2015.

Recently, an **international team of astronomers** has discovered the most distant 'Radio-Loud' Quasar with the help of European Southern Observatory's Very Large Telescope (ESO's VLT).

- China and Russia have agreed to build a International Lunar Research Station (ILRS), possibly on the moon's surface, marking the start of a new era in space cooperation between the two countries.
  - ✓ **Russia** is a part of **International Space Station** which is a habitable **artificial satellite** the single largest manmade structure in **low earth orbit**.
  - ✓ The ILRS is a comprehensive scientific experiment base with the capability of long-term autonomous operation.
  - ✓ The station would be built on the lunar surface and/or on the lunar orbit that would carry out scientific research activities such as the lunar exploration and utilization, lunar-based observation, basic scientific experiment and technical verification.
- France has begun its 1st space military exercises to test its ability to defend its satellites.
  - ✓ The exercise drills are codenamed "AsterX" to commemorate the 1st French satellite Asterix from 1965.
  - ✓ The exercises are part of France's strategy to become the **world's 3<sup>rd</sup>-largest space power**, after the **USA and China**.
  - ✓ These space military exercises are the 1<sup>st</sup> ever attempt not only for the French army but also for Europe.
  - ✓ Moreover, France has planned to **develop anti-satellite** laser weapons and to **strengthen surveillance capabilities** to close the gap with rivals; **China and Russia**.
- ❖ National Institute of Oceanography (NIO) is going to launch the 1st-of-its-kind project of Genome Mapping in the Indian Ocean.
  - ✓ Indian Ocean is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest water body in the world, covering about 20% of the Earth's water surface.
  - ✓ Aim: To gather samples for genome mapping of microorganisms in the Indian Ocean.
    - To understand the biochemistry and the response of the ocean to climate change, nutrient stress and increasing pollution.
  - ✓ **Project Cost & Duration:** Rs. **25 crore** and will take **three years** to complete.
- ❖ NASA and ISRO are collaborating on developing an SUV-sized satellite called NISAR, which will detect movements of the planet's surface as small as 0.4 inches over areas about half the size of a tennis court.
  - ✓ The satellite will be launched in **2022** from the **Satish Dhawan Space Center in Sriharikota** (Andhra Pradesh) into a near-polar orbit.
  - ✓ The Name 'NISAR': The name NISAR is short for NASA-ISRO-SAR.
    - SAR here refers to the Synthetic Aperture Radar that NASA will use to measure changes in the surface of the Earth.
- ❖ India developed its 1<sup>st</sup> indigenously developed Appstore, 'Mobile Seva Appstore'.
  - ✓ Mobile Seva Appstore hosts more than 965 live apps from various domains and categories of public services.
  - ✓ **India** is the largest user of mobile apps. As per **India's App Market Statistics report 2021**, around 5% of apps on Android are from Indian Apps developers.
- ❖ The Ministry of Education has announced to link Online Teacher Pupil Registration Management System (OTPRMS) Certificates with DigiLocker.
  - ✓ The issued certificate will be automatically transferred to DigiLocker.
- Russia has launched its 1st satellite to monitor the Arctic's climate and environment named "Arkitka-M".
  - ✓ The carrier rocket Soyuz-2.1b with Arktika-M satellite was launched from the Baikonur Cosmodrome in Kazakhstan.
  - ✓ This satellite will provide continuous monitoring of the **northern territory of Russia** and the seas of the **Arctic Ocean.** The second satellite is planned to be launched in 2023.
- ❖ Government has decided to integrate Common Service Centres with e-daakhil portal to facilitate the rural consumers for e-filing. E-daakhil portal was launched by National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission on 7 September, 2020.
  - ✓ E-daakhil portal was launched for online redressal of consumer grievances. It is now operational in 15 states and Union Territories.

- ❖ India has reached the 7th position on ICC Men's Cricket World Cup Super League standings.
  - ✓ In the 3<sup>rd</sup> ODI, **India** won over **England** by seven runs. In the series, India won over England by 2-1.
  - ✓ However, England remains top ranked team in ICC Men's Cricket World Cup Super League standings.
- Gin Wigmore's song 'Girl Gang', the female empowerment anthem, will be the official song for the ICC Women's World Cup 2022.
  - ✓ Girl Gang song stands for, I figured I needed to follow through and take care of some business.
  - ✓ The tournament is scheduled from 4 March to 3 April 2022 and it will be hosted by New Zealand.
  - ✓ The 2022 ICC Women's Cricket World Cup will be the 12th edition of the Women's Cricket World Cup.
- ❖ In ISSF World Cup, Indian Trio Rahi Sarnobat, Chinky Yadav, and Manu Bhaker won a gold medal in the women's 25m Pistol Team event.
  - ✓ **Aishwary Pratap Singh Tomar** becomes the **youngest player** to win a **gold medal** in the **3 Positions** event at **ISSF** World Cup.
